To Whom It May Concern at the FEC:

My name is Anjali Sridhar. I am writing regarding the politically-motivated allegations about my campaign contributions to Kumar for Congress. You are laboring under a series of misinformation.

I have not exceeded campaign contribution limits (for Anjali Sridhar).

The limit was \$2900 for the primary election and I contributed a total of \$2800.

There was only a single \$2800 contribution on 2/6/2021. Per Rishi Kumar, the 3 other transactions for 2/6/2021 are duplicates that appeared due to a software glitch and will be corrected in an amendment of January 2023.

According to Mr Kumar , his campaign had explained to the FEC last year about the duplication of records by NGP - the software the campaign uses - during an amendment filing.

Mr. Kumar advises that his campaign was explicitly cleared by Mary Seiler of the FEC who has a written log of this from a campaign discussion with Mary on November 22nd, 2022. Mr. Kumar anticipates that the amendment filing will fix this glitch by removing the duplicates.
