I am in receipt of a letter from Mr. Roy Q. Lockett on this matter, a letter which rather mystifies me. My only contact with anything about Mr. Hunter Biden and his laptop was signing the letter, apparently in October 2022, the letter which is referred to in Mr. Lockett's letter. The letter came to me from former colleagues, distinguished public servants, and made the case that the affair had the earmarks of, or the smell of, a Russian disinformation operation. That was, from my perspective as someone who has managed intelligence agencies, true. Note that we did not say - and I would not have signed -- that it *was* a Russian disinformation operation. We could not know that, especially from outside the government.

I played no part in drafting the letter, not in any follow-up. If I had contact later with any of the other signers, it had nothing to do with Hunter Biden, and the matter surely never came up. I live in California, and so my role in the Biden campaign was very much at the edge. I joined a group of National Security Leaders working for him, but my activity was limited to writing several op-ed pieces, none of which made any mention of Hunter Biden. I am busy and confess I have no idea where the whole issue now stands.

The only conceivable documentation I could supply would be the emails to and from me about signing the letter, but I fear those have long since disappeared from my computer. Let me know if there is anything else I can provide. Thank you. Gregory F. Treverton
