CERTIFICATION

I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary for the Federal Election Commission executive session on May 14, 2024, do hereby certify that the Commission decided by a vote of 6-0 to take the following actions in MUR 8131:

1. Find reason to believe that Nancy Marks violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30102(h)(1) and 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 103.3(a) and 104.3 by failing to deposit receipts into a campaign depository account and by failing to report and incorrectly reporting information regarding receipts, disbursements, and cash on hand.
2. Enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with Nancy Marks prior to a finding of reason to believe.
