I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on August 13, 2024, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Decided by a vote of 4-0 to:

Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated July 10, 2024, subject to the edits most recently circulated by Chairman Cooksey on August 8, 2024 at 12:25 p.m.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the decision. Commissioners Broussard and Weintraub abstained.

2. Decided by a vote of 5-0 to:

- a. Dismiss the allegation that Kyrsten Sinema, Sinema for Arizona, Getting Stuff Done PAC, and Sinema Leadership Fund, and Cynthia Leigh Applebaum in her capacity as treasurer of all three committees, violated 52 U.S.C. § 30114(b) by converting contributions to personal use.
- b. Dismiss the allegation that Sinema for Arizona, Getting Stuff Done PAC, and Sinema Leadership Fund, and Cynthia Leigh Applebaum in her capacity as treasurer of all three committees, violated 52

U.S.C. § 30104(b)(5)(A) by improperly reporting the purpose of expenditures.

- c. Approve the appropriate letters.
- d. Close the file effective 30 days after the date the certification of this vote is signed (or on the next business day after the 30th day, if the 30th day falls on a weekend or holiday).

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, Trainor, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision. Commissioner Broussard abstained.
