CERTIFICATION

I, Vicktoria J. Allen, Deputy Secretary of the Federal Election Commission, do hereby certify that on August 30, 2023, the Commission decided by a vote of 6-0 to take the following actions in AUDREF 23-01:

1. Open a MUR. **MUR # 8162**
2. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion the allegation that Support American Leaders PAC and Matthew Tunstall in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30116(f) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.9 by accepting excessive contributions and issue an admonishment letter.
3. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion the allegation that Support American Leaders PAC and Matthew Tunstall in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.1 and 104.3 by failing to file accurate reports of its cash on hand and issue an admonishment letter.
4. Dismiss as a matter of prosecutorial discretion the allegation that Support American Leaders PAC and Matthew Tunstall in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(4), (g)(2) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 104.3(b)(3)(vii), 104.4(b)(2), (c) by failing to indicate the state in which its IEs were disseminated in connection with a presidential primary election and issue an admonishment letter.
