CERTIFICATION

I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on July 09, 2024, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:
 - a. Find reason to believe that Detroit International Bridge Company, LLC violated 52 U.S.C. § 30119(a) and 11 C.F.R. § 115.2(a) by making a prohibited federal contractor contribution.
 - b. Enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with Detroit International Bridge Company, LLC, prior to a finding of probable cause to believe.
 - c. Take no action at this time as to Never Back Down, Inc. and Cabell Hobbs in his official capacity as treasurer.
 - d. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated May 23, 2024.
 - e. Approve the proposed Conciliation Agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated May 23, 2024.
 - f. Approve the appropriate letter.

Commissioners Broussard, Lindenbaum, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion. Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.

2. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

- a. Dismiss the complaint.
- b. Close the file effective 30 days after the date the certification of this vote is signed (or on the next business day after the 30th day, if the 30th day falls on a weekend or holiday).
- c. Send the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, Trainor voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Broussard, Lindenbaum, and Weintraub dissented.

3. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

- a. Close the file effective 30 days after the date the certification of this vote is signed (or on the next business day after the 30th day falls on a weekend or holiday).
- b. Send the appropriate letters.

Commissioners Broussard, Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, Trainor, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision.
