Dear Ms. Heuser:

On November 7, 2023, your clients, Keth Gross for Florida and Jason D. Boles in his official capacity as treasurer, Keith Gross, Pure Bue, Inc., and 1954 Capital Partners, LLC, were notified that the Federal Election Commission (FEC) received a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). At that time your clients were provided a copy of the complaint and information that a response to the complaint should be submitted in 15 days of the receipt of the notification.

On January 17, 2024, the Commission received additional information from the complaint pertaining to the allegations in the complaint. Enclosed is a copy of the additional information. If you wish to consider this information in your client's response to the allegations, you are hereby afforded an additional 15 days to do so, or we will assume the previous response is also intended for this correspondence.
