CERTIFICATION

I, Romy Lynn Adame-Wilson, recording secretary of the Federal Election Commission executive session, do hereby certify that on February 25, 2025, the Commission took the following actions in the above-captioned matter:

1. Failed by a vote of 2-2 to:
 - a. Dismiss the allegation that Prince George's County, Maryland violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116(a)(1), 30118(a) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 110.1(b), 114.2(b) by making excessive and prohibited in-kind contributions.
 - b. Dismiss the allegation that Angela D. Alsobrooks and Alsobrooks for Senate and Jay Petterson in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116(f), 30118(a) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 110.9, 114.2(d) by knowingly accepting excessive and prohibited in-kind contributions.
 - c. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated December 19, 2024.
 - d.
 - e. Close the file effective 30 days after the date the certification of this vote is signed (or on the next business day after the 30th day, if the 30th day falls on a weekend or holiday).

Commissioners Dickerson, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Broussard and Lindenbaum dissented.

2. Decided by a vote of 4-0 to:

- a. Dismiss the allegation that Prince George's County, Maryland violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116(a)(1), 30118(a) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 110.1(b), 114.2(b) by making excessive and prohibited in-kind contributions.
- b. Dismiss the allegation that Angela D. Alsobrooks and Alsobrooks for Senate and Jay Petterson in his official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30116(f), 30118(a) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 110.9, 114.2(d) by knowingly accepting excessive and prohibited in-kind contributions.
- c. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated December 19, 2024.
- d. Approve the appropriate letters.
- e. Close the file effective 30 days after the date the certification of this vote is signed (or on the next business day after the 30th day, if the 30th day falls on a weekend or holiday).

Commissioners Broussard, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the decision.
