This is in reference to the Complaint you filed with the Federal Election Commission on April 2, 2024, concerning Yes on Prop 36 – Californians for Safer Communities, Sponsored by Golden State Communities f/k/a Californians to Reduce Homelessness, Drug Addiction, and Theft, sponsored by Golden State Communities ("CRHDAT"), Kevin Kiley for Congress and David Bauer in his official capacity as treasurer (the "Committee"), and Kevin Kiley. After considering the circumstances of this matter, the Commission determined to dismiss this matter and voted to close the file, effective April 25, 2025. Any applicable Factual and Legal Analysis or Statements of Reasons available at the time of this letter's transmittal are enclosed.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record today. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action within 60 days of the dismissal, which became effective today. *See* 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(8).
