This is in reference to the complaint filed with the Federal Election Commission on April 10, 2024, concerning the Republican National Committee, *et al.* Based on that complaint, and after considering the circumstances of this matter and information provided in response to the complaint, the Commission determined to dismiss this matter and close the file effective January 6, 2025.

The General Counsel's Report, which more fully explains the basis for the Commission's decision, is enclosed. Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record today. *See* Disclosure of Certain Documents in Enforcement and Other Matters, 81 Fed. Reg. 50,702 (Aug. 2, 2016).

The Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, allows a complainant to seek judicial review of the Commission's dismissal of this action within 60 days of the dismissal, which became effective today. *See* 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(8).

20	The Complaint alleges that an unknown individual or individuals made, and the Republican				
21	National Committee and Kristin Crosbie in her official capacity as treasurer, the national party				
22	committee of the Republican Party (the "RNC"),1 and Save America and Bradley Crate in his				
23	official capacity as treasurer, a nonconnected committee which is a leadership PAC sponsored by				
24	Donald J. Trump, candidate for President in the 2024 election cycle ("Save America"), ² knowingly				
25	accepted contributions in the name of another, in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of				
26	1971, as amended (the "Act"). ³				
27	Complainant states that he examined the committees' disclosure reports and identified				
28	contributions in his name that he did not make. ⁴ The Complaint contains a chart detailing 11 such

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- 1 contributions totaling \$723 disclosed by the RNC (\$315) and Save America (\$408) during the 2014,
- 2 2020, and 2022 election cycles,⁵ as well as a chart with Complainant's "valid" contributions made
- 3 to other political committees.⁶
- In Response, the RNC states that it has received contributions from numerous individuals
- 5 named Stephen Nelson, the name of the Complainant, and that the "discrepancies" alleged in the
- 6 Complaint are "inadvertent database errors." The RNC states that the contributions at issue were
- 7 made by other individuals with the name Stephen Nelson but that its database mistakenly appended
- 8 Complainant's identifying information to those contributions. 8 The RNC states that it will file a
- 9 Form 99 with the Commission to correct the public record and requests that the Commission
- dismiss the Complaint. As of the date of this report, the RNC has not filed a Form 99 regarding the
- 11 contributions in question.¹⁰

In Response, Save America states that the contributions disclosed by it were not fraudulent,

but instead were made by other individuals named Stephen Nelson, as evidenced by the distinct

employer names listed for the contributions identified in the Complaint as fraudulent compared to

those identified as valid. 11 Save America requests that the Commission dismiss the Complaint. 12

Based on its experience and expertise, the Commission has established an Enforcement

Priority System using formal, pre-determined scoring criteria to allocate agency resources and

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assess whether particular matters warrant further administrative enforcement proceedings. These
criteria include (1) the gravity of the alleged violation, taking into account both the type of activity
and the amount in violation; (2) the apparent impact the alleged violation may have had on the
electoral process; (3) the complexity of the legal issues raised in the matter; and (4) recent trends in
potential violations and other developments in the law. This matter is rated as low priority for
Commission action after application of these pre-established criteria. Given that low rating and low
apparent dollar amount at issue, and the expiration of the statute of limitations as to some of the
conduct alleged, we recommend that the Commission dismiss the Complaint, consistent with the
Commission's prosecutorial discretion to determine the proper ordering of its priorities and use of
agency resources. ¹³ We also recommend that the Commission close the file effective 30 days from
the date of certification of this vote is signed (or on the next business day after the 30th day, if the
