Dear Mr. Strigari:

On April 19, 2024, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, Anthony D'Esposito, D'Esposito for New York and Claudia Armendinger in her official capacity as treasurer, and Citizens for D'Esposito, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"). A copy of the Complaint was forwarded to your clients at that time. On January 8, 2025, on the basis of the information in the complaint and information provided by you, the Commission determined to exercise its prosecutorial discretion to dismiss the allegations contained in the Complaint. Accordingly, on January 8, 2025, the Commission voted to close the file in this matter effective February 7, 2025.
