**Subject:** Complaint of violation of laws and rules under the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended , 2 U.S.C. Section 431 *et seq.*

**Complainant:** Steve Jones candidate for Congress in New Mexico Congressional District 1 (Candidate ID# H4NM01140) and Steve Jones NM1 (Committee ID# C00861153) (individually and collectively "Complainant"). Address of Complainant is 133 Monjeau Drive, Ruidoso, New Mexico 88345.

**Respondent:** Louie Sanchez candidate for Congress in New Mexico Congressional District 1 (Candidate ID# H2NM01367), Louie Sanchez for New Mexico (Committee ID# C00875849), and Rob Duncan, Treasurer of Louie Sanchez for New Mexico (individually and collectively "Respondent"). Address of Respondent is 11609 Paganica Way, NE, Albuquerque, New Mexico 87111.

**Complaints:**

1. FEC Form 1 Statement of Organization filed by Respondent on 4/10/2024 does not comply with FEC laws on when a campaign committee is required to be organized. Said form was signed and sworn to under penalties of perjury to be correct.
2. FEC Form 2 Statement of Candidacy filed by Respondent on 4/15/2024 does not comply with FEC laws on when an individual is required to file as a candidate. Said form was signed and sworn to under penalties of perjury to be correct.
3. FEC Form 3 Statement of Receipts and Disbursements for the time period of 1/1/2024 until 3/31/2024 filed by Respondent on 4/15/2024 does not reflect all loans, receipts and disbursements actually received and disbursed by the campaign. Said form was signed and sworn to under penalties of perjury to be correct.
4. Respondent received loans, contribution and made disbursements in violation of FEC laws prior to filing Form 1 & Form 2.
5. Respondent actively campaigned and represented he was legally a congressional candidate with a legally formed congressional committee

months before the filing of Form 1 and Form 2.

### **Knowledge and History of Respondent:**

In election year 2022, Respondent timely filed, on 1/26/2022, Form 1 and Form 2 in a campaign for Congressional District 1 of New Mexico. Acting as Treasurer for the campaign Louie Sanchez was familiar with the \$5,000 threshold requiring a candidate to register. He also knew that as of the date of his defeat in the primary election his status as a candidate expired which would require a new designation should he choose to be a candidate again. Concurrent with the filing of his Form 3, on 7/15/2022, he attached the following statement, " I, Louie Sanchez, candidate of the Sanchez for NM committee (ID: C00802538), do forgive all outstanding candidate loans, and wish to terminate my committee." The FEC did terminate the committee as of that date.

With known activities after the date of termination of the committee, Respondent should have been filing additional Form 3's reflecting ongoing financial activities. The Wells Fargo account for the committee remained opened will reflect subsequent but unreported activities.

### **Chronology of illegal campaign activities:**

**December 24, 2023** - Respondent reported via text message to Corrine Rios, one of his supporters, that he had decided to run for NM Congressional District 1, again. He had been exploring the possibility from August 2023 until that date. He reported that he had been pressured to run by "the party". He indicated that he would be announcing on January 6th, 2024. It has been suggested that Respondent had already hired a campaign consultant and would have signed a contract in excess of the \$5,000 threshold of expected disbursements.

**January 6, 2024** (or about that date) - Respondent sends press release of announcement of "Candidacy" without filing Declaration of Candidacy Form 1 with the FEC. As of this date, he has completed his campaign exploration period and met the \$5,000 of expected disbursement threshold. Within 15 days, Respondent was required to file Form 2 Designation of Principal Campaign Committee.

**December 24, 2023 to January 6, 2024** - Respondent, in violation of NMSA 1978, Section 1-8-30 began obtaining handwritten signatures on "2024 Primary Election Nominating Petition" to meet the required number of voter signatures required for the Secretary of State of New Mexico to place Respondent on the primary ballot. In so doing, Respondent falsely represented that he was engaged in legal campaign activities in conformity with FEC requirements. Line 18 of the example sheet was signed by the candidate and line 17 by a family member at the

same address.

**January 10, 2024 to January 14, 2014** - Respondent presented deceptive credentials of validity of his campaign to the Secretary of State of New Mexico to establish the ability for Republican voters to sign his Nominating Petition on line. Respondent was not a legal candidate with FEC inspite of having met the \$5,000 threshold.

**January 18, 2024** - Respondent entered the online portal of the Secretary of State and signed his own petition for a second time in spite of an oath "I also declare that I have not signed, and will not sign, any nominating petition for more persons that the number of candidates necessary to fill such office at the next ensuing election."

**February 3, 2024** - Respondent's family member, Cassie Sanchez at the same address entered the online portal of the Secretary of State and signed Respondent's petition for a second time in spite of an oath "I also declare that I have not signed, and will not sign, any nominating petition for more persons that the number of candidates necessary to fill such office at the next ensuing election." There were other instances of illegal duplicate voters signatures on manual and online petition forms.

**February 3, 2024** - In spite of all of the duplicate signatures in violation of New Mexico election law, Respondent had only 492 signatures with less than 3 days before the Filing Date of February 6, 2024. Respondent was required to submit 938 legal, acceptable signatures to meet the minimum required by state law. In each communication, Respondent falsely represented that he was a legal candidate.

**February 3, 2024 to February 6, 2024** - Respondent was forced to resort to last minute emergency phone calls and electronic communications to obtain the minimum signatures in time. In the process, representing that he was a legal candidate for the office he sought.

**February 6, 2024** - Respondent supplied a statement of candidacy to the Secretary of State along with required legal signatures. Such statement was sworn to, notarized and made under penalty of perjury and was false.

**January 13, 2024 to April 10, 2024** - Respondent illegally campaigned at many Republican Party Conventions, Caucuses and candidate meet and greet functions. Complainant observed Respondent at events with campaign materials which cost in excess of the \$5,000 threshold required to designate a campaign committee. In many of his speeches, he reiterated that he had been pressured to run by "the

party" and in one instance stated that he required "the party" to make him concessions to induce him to run.

### **Actions to Mitigate Damages to Respondent Undertaken by Complainant:**

**January 3, 2024** - Complainant sent a text message to Corrine Rios, she had signed Respondent's petition on January 10, 2024. *"I just checked, Luis Sanchez had not filed. Any signatures he gets before filing may not be legal."*, and in the next text message *"I meant to say he has not filed with FEC either as candidate or committee. Federal Election laws require that you file with them before undertaking receipts, disbursements or campaigning for a federal political office. Soliciting signatures and representing himself as a candidate for Congress would violate federal law. Filing with the state is not required to campaign but does apply to ballot eligibility."* Complainant expected Rios to communicate the information to Respondent.

**February 7, 2024** - Complainant received a copy of Respondent's filing with the Secretary of State of New Mexico, which included candidate affidavit, manual signatures and online signatures. Complainant took note of razor slim margin of number of signatures required to be placed on the ballot, the number of illegal duplicate signatures and "candidate" signing his own petition twice. Complainant was aware of the Respondent challenging ballot signatures of his opposition in 2022 primary but chose not to challenge Respondent's filing.

**February 14, 2024** - Complainant attended a Republican Party of Bernalillo Executive Officer Meeting at the county office. In that meeting, Complainant told Janice Arnold-Jones directly, while other executive members of the council listened, that Respondent had barely met the number of required signatures, had illegal double signatures and that he had signed his own petition twice. Ms. Arnold-Jones responded that I should challenge Respondent's petition. She was told that was not going to happen but that a bigger problem existed because the Respondent had not filed with the FEC as a candidate nor had he established a campaign committee. Ms. Arnold-Jones was known to be a supporter of the Respondent and was indicated to be the Chairman of the Uniform Rules and Regulations Committee for Bernalillo County. Others in attendance were also known supporters of the Respondent. It was expected that one or more supporters in attendance would inform Respondent that he was not legally registered with the FEC.

**April 1, 2024 to April 7, 2024** - Complainant sent a number of text messages and email to the state party and county chairman inquiring as to who were the Rules Committee Chairman and the proper method of filing a complaint. Complainant concluded that there was no set procedure and some doubt as to proper channel.

There appeared to be no established procedure to investigate potential rule infraction and enforcement. No further action was taken in that direction.

**April 16, 2024** - Complainant downloaded the filings of Respondent and found them to be false and not in compliance with the federal election laws enforced by the FEC. Complainant immediately sent an email to Respondent and the State Chairman requesting a meeting to discuss the filings. The email had attachments of all documents filed by Respondent the day before. The decision was taken that the State Republican Chairman would not intervene in the matter. The Respondent did not reply to the meeting request nor make any response regarding his FEC filings.

**April 16, 2024** - Complainant sought counsel from political consulting firm that is under contract. Their advice was, "The first step would be to file a complaint with FEC." Complainant decided to allow time for the Respondent to either correct the false filings or file a Self-Complaint.

**April 30, 2024** - After two weeks has elapsed, the Respondent's false filings have not been corrected and Complainant has prepared this complaint.

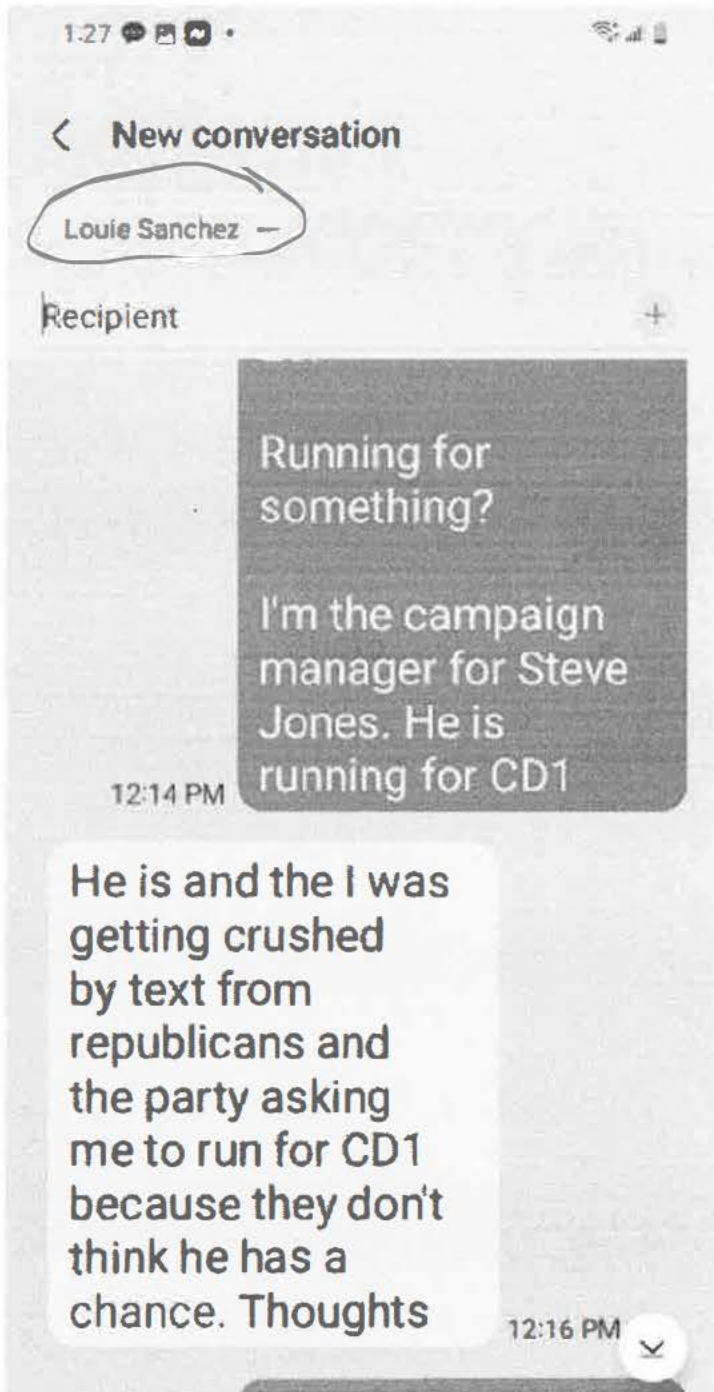

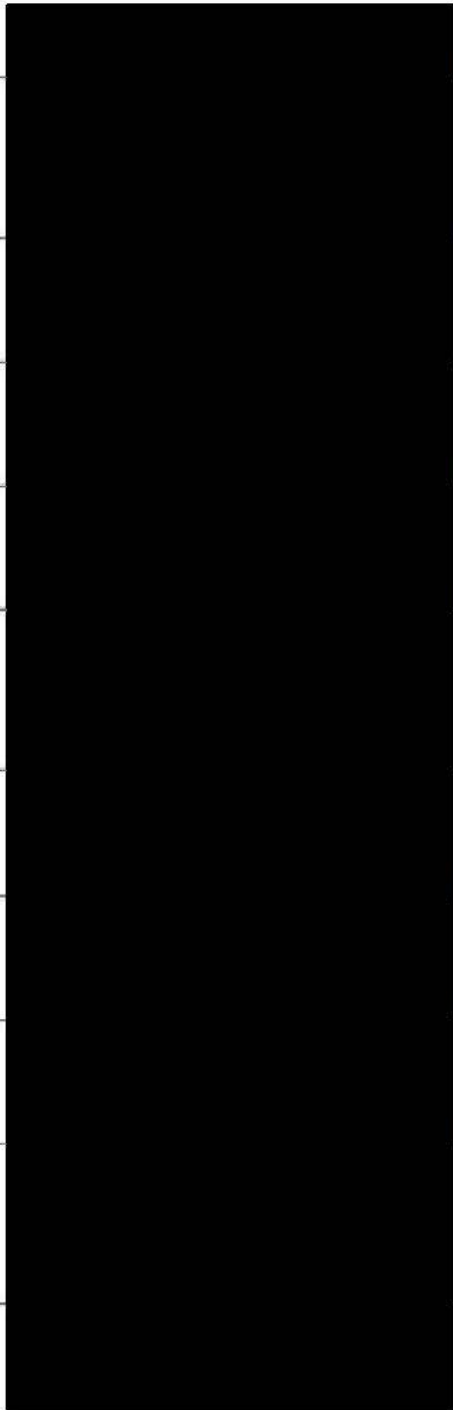

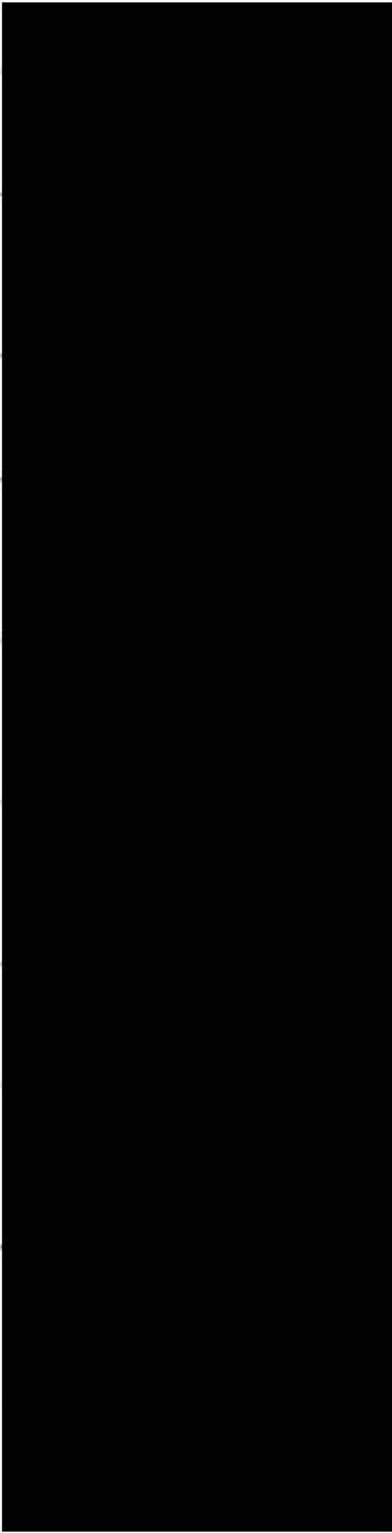
