 19 (Democratic Executive Committee of Florida)
 20 Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

21 On May 14, 2024, the Commission opened a MUR and found reason to believe that
 22 the Democratic Executive Committee of Florida and Fran Garcia in her official capacity as
 23 treasurer (the “Committee”) violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(2), (4) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a),
 24 (b) by failing to timely and accurately disclose \$946,351.72 in receipts and \$990,776.33 in
 25 disbursements on its 2022 October Monthly and 12-Day Pre-General Reports and violated
 26 52 U.S.C. § 30116(f) and 11 C.F.R. § 110.9 by knowingly accepting excessive contributions
 27 in the amount of \$27,880 from individuals and a political action committee.¹ At that time,
 28 the Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause
 29 conciliation with the Committee.² [REDACTED]

30 [REDACTED] We recommend that the Commission
 31 accept the signed conciliation agreement and close the file.
