- 5. Enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with 1199 SEIU United Healthcare Workers East Federal Political Action Fund and Helen Schaub in her official capacity as treasurer.
- 6. Approve the Conciliation Agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated October 11, 2024.
- 7. Approve the appropriate letter.
