I, Vicktoria J. Allen, recording secretary for the Federal Election Commission executive session on October 29, 2024, do hereby certify that the Commission failed by a vote of 3-3 to take the following actions in Audit Referral 24-01:

1. Open a Matter Under Review.
2. Find reason to believe that 1199 SEIU United Healthcare Workers East Federal Political Action Fund and Helen Schaub in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(b)(4)(H)(iii) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.4(a) by failing to disclose independent expenditures on Schedule E of its disclosure reports.
3. Find reason to believe that 1199 SEIU United Healthcare Workers East Federal Political Action Fund and Helen Schaub in her official capacity as treasurer violated 52 U.S.C. § 30104(g)(1) and 11 C.F.R. § 104.4(c) by failing to report independent expenditures.
4. Approve the Factual and Legal Analysis, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated October 11, 2024.
5. Enter into pre-probable cause conciliation with 1199 SEIU United Healthcare Workers East Federal Political Action Fund and Helen Schaub in her official capacity as treasurer.
6. Approve the Conciliation Agreement, as recommended in the First General Counsel's Report dated October 11, 2024.
7. Approve the appropriate letter.
