In response to the complaint filed against Culp for Congress, the Committee responds as follows.

The Committee did not omit debt from its reports and was unaware of the claimed debt. Upon the conclusion of the campaign, in 2022, the Committee paid what they believed to be the total owed to the vendor, Dave's Campaign Business Solutions.

The four invoices being claimed by the vendor as unpaid, were thought to have been paid by the Committee and being sent as a clerical error on the part of the vendor. The Committee does not have record of the vendor reaching out to the treasurer to inquire about payment. The automated emails sent to the Committee from Quickbooks for the four invoices were discontinued and the Committee assumed the clerical error was corrected.

Further, per the invoices which were attached to the original complaint, the pricing offered on the invoices was for invoices paid in full at the time of order, further leading the committee to believe that if the service had been offered, then the invoices had been paid.

There is no written agreement between the vendor and Campaign to provide services and the Committee has been terminated since December of 2022.

The Committee was committed to accurate reporting throughout the length of the campaign.
