## CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL LAW ENFORCEMENT SUIT

Respondent Calspan Corporation consents to toll the statute of limitations for any civil enforcement action that the Federal Election Commission might institute in connection with Pre-MUR 669 pursuant to 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(6) for a period of 98 days from March 4, 2024, the date of the inquiry from the Office of General Counsel to counsel for Calspan Corporation regarding whether Calspan executives, David Meier, and former Chief Executive Officer of Calspan, Peter Sauer, would join in on the *sua sponte* Submission through June 10, 2024, the date of the supplemental Submission from Mr. Sauer's counsel indicating his intention to join in on the Submission.

This agreement will extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit for a period of 98 calendar days from the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462 or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter.

There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement suit without the written consent of the Respondent.
