SUBJECT: MUR 8363 (Calspan, *et al.*)
Recommendation to Accept Signed Conciliation Agreement

On January 28, 2025, the Commission found reason to believe that Calspan Corporation (“Calspan”) violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30122, 30118(a), and 30119(a) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 110.4(b)(1)(i), 114.2(d), and 115.2(a); that Peter Sauer and David Meier violated 52 U.S.C. §§ 30122 and 30118(a) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 110.4(b)(1)(ii) and 114.2(e), provisions of the Federal Campaign Election Act of 1971, as amended (the “Act”) and the Commission’s regulations.¹ The Commission authorized the Office of General Counsel to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Committee and approved a conciliation agreement [REDACTED]


