GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Allegations

Robert R. Pipkin, Jr., has alleged that the Citizens for Richardson Committee ("the Committee") violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 (b)(12) by failing to report outstanding debts of \$2,372 which the Committee owed to Robert R. Pipkin, Jr.; and debts of \$549.34 which the Committee owed to FD Productions. Mr. Pipkin included in his complaint an October 14, 1978, letter to the Committee from Zack Burkett of FD Productions requesting payment of \$549.34. The Citizens for Richardson Committee registered as the principal campaign committee for Gary Richardson, an unsuccessful candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives from the 2nd District of Oklahoma.

Previous Commission Action

On January 5, 1979, the Commission found reason to believe that Citizens for Richardson may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 (b)(12). The Committee was notified of the Commission's determination in a letter dated January 11, 1979.

Evidence and Analysis

Lloyd Payton, counsel for the Committee, responded to the Commission's notification in a letter dated February 27, 1979 (Attachment I). Mr. Payton stated that the Committee was not aware that Zack Burkett of FD Productions was alleging that the

campaign was still indebted to him. Mr. Payton enclosed a copy of an October 20, 1978, cancelled Committee check for \$549.34 made payable to FD Productions which is the exact amount which Mr. Burkett requested in his October 14, 1978, letter to the Committee; the check was drawn on the Citizens National Bank in Oklahoma, and cashed at the National Bank of Commerce in Texas. This payment was reported on the Committee's 10 day pre-election report, and appears to settle the Committee's debt to FD Productions.

With respect to the allegation that the Committee owes debts of \$2372.39 to Robert T. Pipkin, Jr., for consulting fees and campaign related expenditures, the Committee contests those allegations. Mr. Payton states that:

Mr. Pipkin was hired by our campaign on the basis that he was an "expert" campaign manager and further, it was fully understood that he took responsibility for running the entire campaign which specifically included the fact that he would see to it that necessary funds were raised to pay salaries, expenses, etc.

Mr. Payton further stated that when Mr. Pipkin failed at these responsibilities, he was fired by the Committee. Part of Mr. Pipkin's claim is that the Committee owes him travel expenses to move back to Texas after he was fired. Since neither Mr. Pipkin nor the Committee presented an employment contract, it is unclear whether Mr. Pipkin has a legitimate claim. In any event, it appears that the dispute over the "debt" of \$2372.39 involves only Mr. Pipkin and the Committee, and is a private dispute between the parties. Thus, it is not within the Commission's jurisdiction to determine whether the Committee is liable for Mr. Pipkin's expenses.

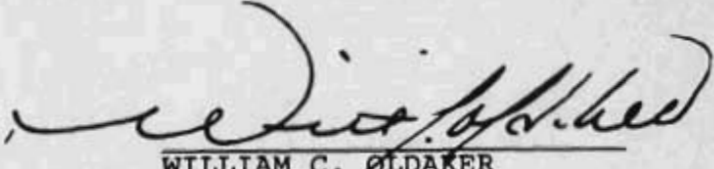
INTERIM INVESTIGATIVE REPORT

The allegations in MUR 888 are that the Citizens for Richardson Committee may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b) (12) if it owes undisclosed debts as alleged by Robert R. Pipkin, Jr. The Commission, on January 5, 1979, found reason to believe that a violation may have occurred.

On January 23, 1979, Gary Richardson called the Office of General Counsel. He stated that a copy of Mr. Pipkin's complaint had not been included in the Commission's notification letter. He requested a copy of the complaint, the Federal Election Campaign Act, and the Regulations. The Federal Election Commission has received a complaint which alleges that your committee violated certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). A copy of the complaint is enclosed. We have numbered this matter MUR 888.

The Commission, on January 5, 1979, found reason to believe that the matters alleged therein state a violation of 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(12). Specifically, it appears that the Citizens for Richardson Committee may have violated the Act if it owes debts of \$2,372.30 to Robert R. Pipkin, Jr.; and debts of \$549.34 to FD Productions as alleged by the Complainant.

BACKGROUND

On December 5, 1978, the Commission received a notarized complaint from Robert R. Pipkin, Jr. alleging that the Citizens for Richardson Committee ("the Committee") violated 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(12) by failing to report outstanding debts which the Committee owed to Robert R. Pipkin, Jr. and FD Productions (Attachment I). The Citizens for Richardson Committee is registered as the principal campaign committee for Gary Richardson, an unsuccessful candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives from the 2nd District of Oklahoma.

EVIDENCE

Mr. Pipkin alleges that the Committee owes him \$2,372.39 for consulting fees and campaign related expenditures; and the Committee owes FD Productions \$549.34 for production of television spots. Mr. Pipkin supplied copies of his bills and invoices which were sent to the Committee. Also he sent a copy of a letter which FD Productions sent to the Committee. A review of the Committee's reports reveal previous payments to Robert Pipkin, Jr.; however these do not appear to be payments for the services described in the complaint. There was no indication of any prior committee payments to FD Productions.

ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. §434(b)(12) requires that political committees report the amount and nature of debts and obligations owed by the committee. 11 C.F.R. §§104.2 and 104.8 also deal with reporting of a committee's debts and obligations. It appears that the Citizens for Richardson Committee may have violated 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(12) if the Committee owes debts to Robert R. Pipkin, Jr. and FD Productions as alleged by the complainant.

RECOMMENDATION

Find reason to believe that the Citizens for Richardson Committee may have violated 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(12). Send attached letter.

Specifically, it appears that the Citizens for Richardson Committee may have violated the Act if it owes debts of \$2,372.30 to Robert R. Pipkin, Jr.; and debts of \$549.34 to FD Productions as alleged by the Complainant.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you. Please submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's analysis of this matter. These materials may include any contracts or agreements between the committee and Mr. Pipkin or FD Productions, if any. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

The Commission is under a duty to investigate this matter expeditiously. Therefore, your response should be submitted within ten days after your receipt of this notification.
