GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

I. Background

79040132223
A review of the 10 day pre-primary and July 10 quarterly reports for 1978 filed by the Sherck for Congress Committee (the "Sherck Committee") disclosed contributions in excess of the \$1,000 limit from the Democratic Fifth District Committee (the "Democratic Committee"), in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A). On May 5, 1978, the Democratic Committee contributed \$1,500 to the Sherck Committee for the primary and on June 29, 1978, \$1,800 for the general election.

Surface violations letters went out to both respondents on November 1, 1978. Both committees later responded by saying \$1,300 was refunded to the Democratic Committee. This matter was then referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division. On January 17, 1979, the Commission found reason to believe that the Democratic Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A) and that the Sherck Committee violated § 441a(f).

II. Evidence

On January 30, 1979, Jim Sherck, candidate, called the Commission to explain the situation and to state that his treasurer would be sending in a notarized statement. This statement was received February 5, 1979 (see Attachment 1). According to

Mr. Sherck and Marlene Purdy, the treasurer, there was much confusion regarding the Democratic Committee and the acceptability of their contribution. As the Democratic Committee had made large contributions to candidates in the past, the Sherck Committee assumed the contribution to be within legal limits. ^{1/}

7904013224 Adding to the confusion was the fact that the Reports Analysis Division was under the erroneous impression that the Democratic Committee was registered with the Commission as the principal campaign committee for Bruce Edwards. ^{2/} Therefore, the Democratic Committee was required to file another Statement of Organization reflecting their status as a county committee of the Democratic Party. When it was determined the Democratic Committee would not qualify as a multicandidate political committee, the contributions in question were deemed excessive and a refund was required.

Mr. Sherck stated that he was prepared to refund the money as soon as his committee received the first notice from the Commission but was advised by RAD to wait until the status of the Democratic Committee was determined. As the Sherck Committee had no funds, Mr. Sherck paid back the excess amounts with his own personal funds on November 10, 1978.

1. A review of the Democratic Committee's reports and those of the principal campaign committee of Bruce Edwards, 1976 congressional candidate, indicates a possible excessive contribution might have been made by the Democratic Committee to Edwards' committee. This, however, cannot be confirmed by either of the committees' reports due to their inadequacies and therefore will not be made part of this MUR.
2. This was not the case and the error was due to the similar names of both committees.

Joyce Wise, treasurer of the Democratic Committee, called the Commission on February 12, 1979 (after an attempt had been made to reach her on February 7, 1979) and said she thought the whole thing had been cleared up. A letter, subsequent to that conversation, was received by the Commission on February 26, 1979, in which Ms. Wise simply reiterated the facts already known to the Commission (see Attachment 2).

III. Analysis

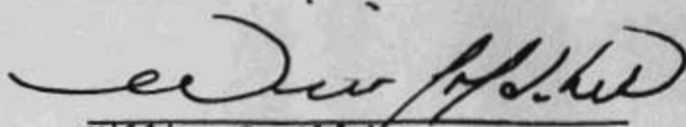
Here the excessive contributions were clearly made and received. While the Democratic Committee gave no reason as to why it made the excessive contributions, it, like the Sherck Committee, seemed to be guided by the mistaken belief that the Democratic Committee was a multicandidate committee and had a \$5,000 limitation. Therefore, the Office of General Counsel recommends a finding of reasonable cause to believe with regard to both violations and proposes a civil penalty of \$650 for each respondent.

IV. Recommendations

1. Find reasonable cause to believe that the Democratic Fifth District Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A) and the Sherck for Congress Committee violated § 441a(f).
2. Approve the attached conciliation agreements.

Dear Members of the Commission:

I, Marlene Purdy, treasurer of the Sherck for Congress Committee, being first duly sworn, say as follows:

I hereby acknowledge receipt of your letter dated January 19, 1979, which was received by me on January 27, 1979, informing the Sherck for Congress Committee that the committee may have violated a section of the Federal Campaign Act in that it accepted excess money from the Democratic Fifth District Committee.

As treasurer of the committee, I acknowledge accepting the contribution from the Fifth District, but, specifically deny having any knowledge, whatsoever, that the contribution was illegal at the time I accepted it.

The Fifth District Democratic Party organization has existed for many, many years. Over the years, it had a tradition of contributing monies, which the individual counties contributed to it, to the Congressional candidate, whoever that candidate was. The Fifth District Party also contributed to other candidates running for state and federal office over a period of these years.

Upon receipt of the money from the Fifth District, Mr. Sherck and I both concluded the contributions were legal because the Fifth District had existed for many years and had traditionally contributed rather large sums to the Congressional candidate. At the time, we believed the Fifth District was a political party entity, not a corporate political action committee or a union political action committee, and therefore had some kind of exemption, either under the multi-candidate committee or under another section of the law exempting political parties. We accepted the contribution.

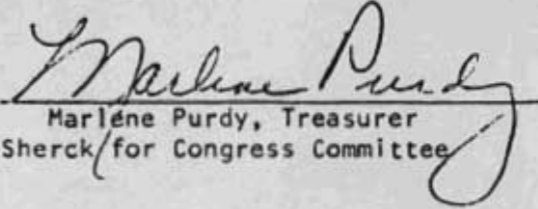
A short time thereafter, we received notice from the Federal Election Commission that it may have been an illegal contribution. Immediately, our committee contacted the Federal Election Commission to find out the status of the contribution. We talked to several people at the Federal Election Headquarters, including one Michael Kelly. There appeared to be a great deal of confusion as to what status the Fifth District Committee had. As it turned out, the Fifth District Committee had never filed its own status report. It was listed as a campaign committee of Bruce Edwards, who was the former Congressional candidate in the Fifth District. At this point, we offered to refund the money. But, we were told not to refund the money until the Fifth District cleared up its identity problem at which time the Federal Election Commission would make a determination as to whether the contribution should be refunded or not. The suggestion was made to me that we could file a form authorizing the Fifth District Committee to be one of our campaign committees and therefore accept the contribution in full. After discussing this with Candidate Sherck, we concluded it would be inappropriate to do this. We did not have the complete records of the Fifth District funds; and, we did not want to be responsible for giving our approval to a committee that we did not have control over from the start. Also, it would have been inappropriate to make the Fifth District our campaign committee as no one ever authorized the Fifth District Committee to be such. We felt this would be improper.

Time elapsed and it is our understanding that the Fifth District Committee then filed its proper reports. A week before the election, we received notice the contribution was apparently illegal and that we had to refund the money. At this point, our committee was effectively broke and Jim Sherck reached into his own personal funds and contributed to the committee so that the money could be refunded.

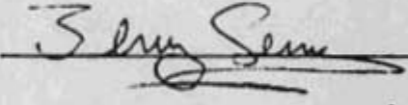
I can say with absolute certainty that there was never any knowledge on our part that we were doing anything illegal by accepting this contribution. In fact, as the matter unfolded, we were very careful to follow the advice of the Federal Election Commission and promptly refunded the money when requested to do so. In fact, we offered to refund it sometime earlier.

Since the refund of the money itself placed a great hardship on the committee and on the candidate, we feel it would be unfair to assess any additional penalties at this time for what was honest confusion of the law regarding the status of the Fifth District.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter having been initiated on the basis of information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, an investigation having been conducted, and the Commission having found reasonable cause to believe that respondent, the Democratic Fifth District Committee (the "Committee"), violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A) by contributing in excess of \$1,000 per election to the Sherck for Congress Committee.

Now, therefore, the respective parties herein, the Federal Election Commission and respondent the Democratic Fifth District Committee having duly entered into conciliation pursuant to § 437g(a)(5), do hereby agree as follows:

- I. That the Federal Election Commission has jurisdiction over respondent and the subject of this proceeding.
- II. That respondent has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.
- III. That the pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:
 - A. That respondent Committee is a political committee under 2 U.S.C. § 431(d).
 - B. That respondent Committee does not fulfill the definition of a multicandidate political committee pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(4).

- C. Therefore, respondent Committee has a contribution limitation of \$1,000 per election with respect to any election for federal office, pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A).
- D. That respondent Committee contributed \$1,500 for the 1978 primary election and \$1,800 for the 1978 general election to the Sherck for Congress Committee.
- E. That on or about November 16, 1978, \$1,300 was refunded to the respondent Committee by the Sherck for Congress Committee.

THEREFORE, respondent agrees:

- IV. That respondent Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A) by contributing in excess of \$1,000 per election to the Sherck for Congress Committee.
- V. That it will pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$650 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6)(B).
- VI. Respondent agrees that it will not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

- VII. The Commission, on the request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein, or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

Now, therefore, the respective parties herein, the Federal Election Commission and respondent Sherck for Congress Committee having duly entered into conciliation pursuant to §437g(a)(5), do hereby agree as follows:

- I. That the Federal Election Commission has jurisdiction over respondent and the subject of this proceeding.
- II. That respondent has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.
- III. That the pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:
 - A. That respondent Committee was the principal campaign committee for candidate Jim Sherck, pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §431(n).

- B. Pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §441a(a)(1)(A) no person shall make contributions to any candidate and his authorized political committees with respect to any election for Federal office which, in the aggregate, exceed \$1,000 and pursuant to §441a(f) no such committee may knowingly accept such excess contributions.
- C. That respondent Committee accepted contributions in excess of \$1,000 from the Democratic Fifth District Committee, as follows: \$1,500 for the 1978 primary election and \$1,800 for the 1978 general election.
- D. That on or about November 16, 1978 respondent Committee did refund the excess amount to the Democratic Fifth District Committee.

THEREFORE, respondent agrees:

- IV. Respondent's action of knowingly accepting contributions in excess of \$1,000 per election from the Democratic Fifth District Committee violated 2 U.S.C. §441a(f).
- V. That it will pay a civil penalty in the amount of \$650 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §437g(a)(6)(B).
- VI. Respondent agrees that it will not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. §431, et seq.

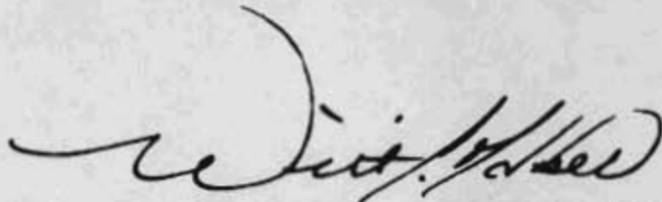

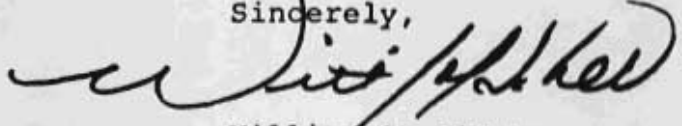

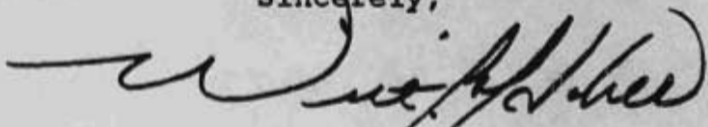

I, Marlene Purdy, treasurer of the Sherck for Congress Committee, being first duly sworn, say as follows:

I hereby acknowledge receipt of your letter dated January 19, 1979, which was received by me on January 27, 1979, informing the Sherck for Congress Committee that the committee may have violated a section of the Federal Campaign Act in that it accepted excess money from the Democratic Fifth District Committee.

As treasurer of the committee, I acknowledge accepting the contribution from the Fifth District, but, specifically deny having any knowledge, whatsoever, that the contribution was illegal at the time I accepted it.

The Fifth District Democratic Party organization has existed for many, many years. Over the years, it had a tradition of contributing monies, which the individual counties contributed to it, to the Congressional candidate, whoever that candidate was. The Fifth District Party also contributed to other candidates running for state and federal office over a period of these years.

Upon receipt of the money from the Fifth District, Mr. Sherck and I both concluded the contributions were legal because the Fifth District had existed for many years and had traditionally contributed rather large sums to the Congressional candidate. At the time, we believed the Fifth District was a political party entity, not a corporate political action committee or a union political action committee, and therefore had some kind of exemption, either under the multi-candidate committee or under another section of the law exempting political parties. We accepted the contribution.

A short time thereafter, we received notice from the Federal Election Commission that it may have been an illegal contribution. Immediately, our committee contacted the Federal Election Commission to find out the status of the contribution. We talked to several people at the Federal Election Headquarters, including one Michael Kelly. There appeared to be a great deal of confusion as to what status the Fifth District Committee had. As it turned out, the Fifth District Committee had never filed its own status report. It was listed as a campaign committee of Bruce Edwards, who was the former Congressional candidate in the Fifth District. At this point, we offered to refund the money. But, we were told not to refund the money until the Fifth District cleared up its identity problem at which time the Federal Election Commission would make a determination as to whether the contribution should be refunded or not. The suggestion was made to me that we could file a form authorizing the Fifth District Committee to be one of our campaign committees and therefore accept the contribution in full. After discussing this with Candidate Sherck, we concluded it would be inappropriate to do this. We did not have the complete records of the Fifth District funds; and, we did not want to be responsible for giving our approval to a committee that we did not have control over from the start. Also, it would have been inappropriate to make the Fifth District our campaign committee as no one ever authorized the Fifth District Committee to be such. We felt this would be improper.

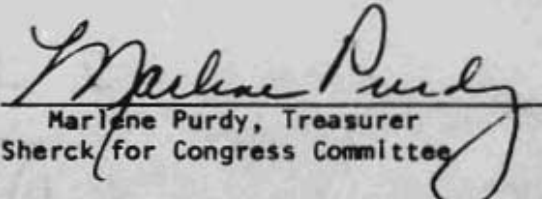

Time elapsed and it is our understanding that the Fifth District Committee then filed its proper reports. A week before the election, we received notice the contribution was apparently illegal and that we had to refund the money. At this point, our committee was effectively broke and Jim Sherck reached into his own personal funds and contributed to the committee so that the money could be refunded.

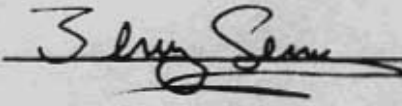
I can say with absolute certainty that there was never any knowledge on our part that we were doing anything illegal by accepting this contribution. In fact, as the matter unfolded, we were very careful to follow the advice of the Federal Election Commission and promptly refunded the money when requested to do so. In fact, we offered to refund it sometime earlier.

Since the refund of the money itself placed a great hardship on the committee and on the candidate, we feel it would be unfair to assess any additional penalties at this time for what was honest confusion of the law regarding the status of the Fifth District.

GENERATION OF MATTER

A review of the 10 day pre-primary and July 10 quarterly reports for 1978 filed by the Sherck for Congress Committee (the "Sherck Committee") 1/ disclosed excessive contributions from the Democratic Fifth District Committee (the "Democratic Committee"), in violation of 2 U.S.C. §441a(a)(1)(A). On May 5, 1978, the Democratic Committee contributed \$1,500 to the Sherck Committee for the primary, indicating there was a joint fundraiser with the Sherck Committee. This was later disclaimed by the Sherck Committee. 2/ On June 29, 1978, the Democratic Committee contributed \$1,800 to the Sherck Committee for the general election.

This matter was referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division on December 12, 1978 (See Attachment 1).

1/ James Sherck was the Democratic candidate for the U.S. Congress from the 5th District of Ohio. He was defeated in the general election receiving 43,442 votes (35% of the total votes cast).

2/ In a response to a Request for Additional Information from the Reports Analysis Division, the Sherck Committee stated the fundraiser was planned, financed and promoted solely by the Democratic Committee.

EVIDENCE

Both respondents were notified of the surface violation on November 1, 1978. Each committee responded by saying \$1,300 was refunded to the Democratic Committee (\$500 excess amount for the primary and \$800 excess amount for the general). On subsequent reports, both committees recorded this transfer of funds.

PRELIMINARY ANALYSIS

2 U.S.C. §441a(a)(1)(A) renders it unlawful for a person to make contributions to any candidate and his authorized political committee with respect to any election for Federal office which, in the aggregate, exceed \$1,000.

Since the Democratic Committee has not supported five federal candidates and is not affiliated with any qualified multicandidate committee, it is not subject to the higher contribution limitations of qualified multicandidate committees. It is subject instead to the \$1,000 limitation.

Further, a political committee cannot knowingly accept any contribution in violation of this section. See §441a(f).

RECOMMENDATION

1. Find reason to believe that the Democratic Fifth District Committee violated 2 U.S.C. §441a(a)(1)(A).
2. Find reason to believe that the Sherck for Congress Committee violated 2 U.S.C. §441a(f).

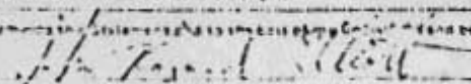
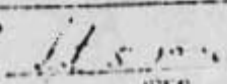

This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting candidates and committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended. During review of the 10 Day Pre-Primary and the 30 Day Post-Primary Reports of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed entries indicating that you have made contributions which exceed the limits set forth in the Act. A copy of that portion of your reports is attached so that a review of your records can be made.

The Act precludes individuals and political committees, other than multicandidate political committees, from making political contributions to a candidate for Federal office in excess of \$1,000 per election. The Act defines a multicandidate committee as one which has been registered with the Commission for a period of not less than six months; has received contributions from more than fifty persons; and has made contributions to five or more candidates for Federal office.

The Commission recommends that if you have made contributions in excess of the limits set forth in the Act that you notify the recipients and request refunds of the amounts in excess of \$1,000. By separate letters to the recipients we have recommended that such refunds be made upon confirmation from you that the contributions were in excess of the limits. These returns should be reported immediately by letter and should be reflected as refunds on your next report of receipts and expenditures. If you find that the entries in question are incomplete or incorrect, please submit a statement which would clarify these particular matters for the public record. You may do so by amending your original report of receipts and expenditures.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting candidates and committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended. During review of the 10 Day Pre-Primary and the July 10 Reports of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed entries indicating that you may have received contributions which exceed the limits set forth in the Act. A copy of that portion of your report is attached so that a review of your records can be made.

The Act precludes individuals and political committees, other than multicandidate committees, from making political contributions to a candidate for Federal election in excess of \$1,000 per election. The Act defines a multicandidate committee as one which has been registered for a period of not less than six months; has received contributions from more than fifty persons; and has made contributions to five or more candidates for Federal office. The committees listed as the sources of the contributions in question do not presently qualify as multicandidate committees and we have notified them accordingly. We have recommended that the source committees notify you if it is confirmed that the contribution each made was in excess of the limits.

The Commission recommends that if you find the contributions you received were in excess of the limits set forth in the Act you return the amounts in excess of \$1,000 to the donors. These returns should be reported immediately by letter and should be reflected as contribution refunds on your next report of receipts and expenditures. If you find that the entries in question are incomplete or incorrect, please submit a statement which would clarify these particular matters for the public record. You may do so by amending your original reports by letter.

I received a phone call after normal working hours from a Marlene A. Purdy, Treasurer of the Sherck for Congress Committee. She had called earlier and discussed some apparent violations with Kevin Kelly. She felt that during the course of the conversation she did not make herself clear on what she considered the proper Committee status of the Democratic Fifth District Committee. I told her that I was not familiar with the case and that I could only answer basic questions about reporting transfers. She contended that this Committee was a Party Committee and the contribution was reported as a transfer-in. She also stated that the Democratic Fifth District Committee was not an authorized committee designated by the Candidate, however, it would accept its support. She reiterated that there was never any intention to engage in a joint fundraiser with the Democratic Fifth District Committee and the Sherck for Congress Committee.

Based on information ascertained in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities, the Federal Election Commission has found reason to believe that Sherck for Congress Committee may have violated certain provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). Specifically, it appears that your committee accepted excessive contributions from the Democratic Fifth District Committee, in violation of 2 U.S.C. §441a(f). While we note the excessive amount has been refunded, the Act was violated when you knowingly accepted these contributions. We have numbered this matter MUR 897.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you. Please submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's analysis of this matter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

The Commission is under a duty to investigate this matter expeditiously. Therefore, your response should be submitted within ten days after your receipt of this notification.

This matter will remain confidential in accordance with 2 U.S.C. Section 437g(a)(3)(B) unless you notify the Commission in writing that you wish the investigation to be made public.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting candidates and committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended. During review of the 10 Day Pre-Primary and the 30 Day Post-Primary Reports of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed entries indicating that you have made contributions which exceed the limits set forth in the Act. A copy of that portion of your reports is attached so that a review of your records can be made.

The Act precludes individuals and political committees, other than multicandidate political committees, from making political contributions to a candidate for Federal office in excess of \$1,000 per election. The Act defines a multicandidate committee as one which has been registered with the Commission for a period of not less than six months; has received contributions from more than fifty persons; and has made contributions to five or more candidates for Federal office.

The Commission recommends that if you have made contributions in excess of the limits set forth in the Act that you notify the recipients and request refunds of the amounts in excess of \$1,000. By separate letters to the recipients we have recommended that such refunds be made upon confirmation from you that the contributions were in excess of the limits. These returns should be reported immediately by letter and should be reflected as refunds on your next report of receipts and expenditures. If you find that the entries in question are incomplete or incorrect, please submit a statement which would clarify these particular matters for the public record. You may do so by amending your original report of receipts and expenditures.

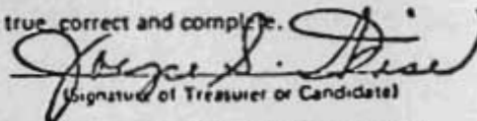

This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting candidates and committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended. During review of the 10 Day Pre-Primary and the July 10 Reports of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed entries indicating that you may have received contributions which exceed the limits set forth in the Act. A copy of that portion of your report is attached so that a review of your records can be made.

The Act precludes individuals and political committees, other than multicandidate committees, from making political contributions to a candidate for Federal election in excess of \$1,000 per election. The Act defines a multicandidate committee as one which has been registered for a period of not less than six months; has received contributions from more than fifty persons; and has made contributions to five or more candidates for Federal office. The committees listed as the sources of the contributions in question do not presently qualify as multicandidate committees and we have notified them accordingly. We have recommended that the source committees notify you if it is confirmed that the contribution each made was in excess of the limits.

The Commission recommends that if you find the contributions you received were in excess of the limits set forth in the Act you return the amounts in excess of \$1,000 to the donors. These returns should be reported immediately by letter and should be reflected as contribution refunds on your next report of receipts and expenditures. If you find that the entries in question are incomplete or incorrect, please submit a statement which would clarify these particular matters for the public record. You may do so by amending your original reports by letter.

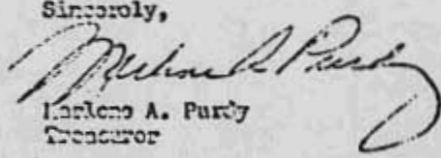

Ms. Purdy called this afternoon in response to an RFAI which I had sent them concerning a fundraiser with the DEMOCRATIC FIFTH DISTRICT COMMITTEE. Ms. Purdy stated that it was not a joint fundraiser but rather a fundraiser for Mr. Sherck and the candidates for state office (Sen. Glenn was the speaker). She went on to explain that the D5DC was not affiliated with the PCC in the sense that all of their actions are controlled by the PCC. She stated that the D5DC merely supports the candidacy of Mr. Sherck. I continued to inquire if the D5DC was an authorized committee to which she replied that it was only authorized to the point that they (PCQ) accept its support. I explained to her that the PCC has received several contributions from the D5DC, which since it is not an authorized committee and not a multicandidate committee, was not allowed to make those contributions. She said that it was a multicandidate committee since it supports many candidates, mostly state and local ones. I then read her the definition of a multicandidate committee, showing her that they must support five Federal candidates. She then asked me what she should do. I told her that she should expect some correspondence from me in the near future outlining the problems. (She said that she mailed her response to the RFAI, which is outstanding, yesterday).
