GENERATION OF MATTER

The El Paso County Republican Central Committee (the Committee) was referred to the Office of General Counsel by the Reports Analysis Division (RAD) on April 5, 1979 because of the Committee's receipt of in-kind contributions from a corporation.

EVIDENCE

The Committee in their October 10, 1977 Report disclosed receipts totalling \$4,721.28 from the Garden Valley Center Building. A RFAI was sent asking the Committee to clarify the nature of the transactions. In response, the treasurer, Robert Lynch, telephoned the Commission and explained that the receipts in question were in-kind contributions from a corporation in the form of rent free office space. He further stated that the reason the amount shown was so high was because the previous treasurer had never reported it and it had been going on since sometime in 1976.

In addition, Mr. Lynch informed RAD that the Committee, in order to be in full compliance with the law, had recently opened a separate bank account to be used for federal elections. A letter to this effect had already been sent to the Commission.

Subsequent to this telephone conversation, Mr. Lynch amended the October 10 Report to correctly reflect the in-kind contributions. A surface violation letter was then sent, and when no response was received, the Commission, on April 10, 1978, found reason to believe the Committee may be in violation of 2 U.S.C. §441b.

On July 3, 1978, Mr. Lynch sent in a new registration for the federal account committee and terminated the state and local account committee. Prior to this, both a Year End Report for 1977 and an April 10, 1978 Quarterly Report had been filed for the federal account committee. In these reports reimbursements were made to the state account for rent.

ANALYSIS

Although the rent free office space provided to the Committee constitutes an in-kind contribution from a corporation, a review of the Committee's reports for 1976 and 1977 does not disclose any federal activity. In light of this and the fact that the Committee now has a segregated account and pays for its rent, the Office of General Counsel recommends no further action in this matter.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Take no further action in regard to possible violations of 2 U.S.C. §441b by the El Paso County Republican Central Committee.
2. Close the file.
3. Approve the attached letter.

He called in response to an RFAI which had requested clarification of a receipt from the Garden Valley Center Building. He stated that he had spoken with someone at the RNC and had learned that his committee was not in full compliance with the law. He was advised by the RNC to split his committee's accounts. He told me that the Garden Valley Center Bldg. was a corporation and that the committee had received rent free office space from the corporation. I stated that I would check the document which he had filed for the new account and get back to him.

I called back and informed him that he had to respond specifically to the RFAI he had been sent. He should do this by stating that the contribution was from a corporation and that it was "in-kind". I further stated that we would have to find some way to remedy the corporate contribution. The splitting of accounts was not sufficient.

He stated that the old treasurer had never reported this in-kind contribution and that was the reason for the huge amount reported on this year's Q3. He said that the free rent covered back into 1976. I told him to mail a response to the RFAI and that I would be back in touch with him concerning the new federal account.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's interest in assisting candidates and committees who wish to comply with the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended. During review of the October 10 Amendment Report of Receipts and Expenditures, we noticed an entry indicating that you may have accepted a contribution from a corporation. Corporate contributions are prohibited by the Act, unless the contribution is made by a separate segregated fund established by the corporation. A copy of that portion of your report is attached for your review and clarification.

The Commission recommends that if you have accepted a prohibited contribution that you return the full amount to the donor. The return of the contribution should be reported immediately by letter and should be reflected as a contribution refund on your next report of receipts and expenditures. If the identification of the source of this contribution is incomplete or incorrect on the original report, please submit a statement which would clarify this particular matter for the public record. You may do so by amending your original report by letter.

Please notify the Commission within ten (10) days of receipt of this letter of the determination made on this matter.
