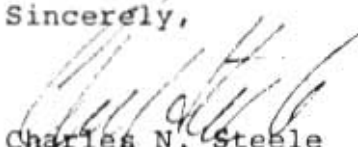

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Allegations

Based on a complaint filed by John M. Gallagher, Jr., Chairman of the Edgar for Congress Committee, the Commission, on July 2, 1979, found reason to believe; and on October 24, 1979, reasonable cause to believe, that the Kane for Congress Committee ("Kane Committee") may have violated 2 U.S.C. §434 by omitting contributor information from its 30 Day Post-General Election Report and for failing to provide adequate information on a fundraising dinner. A proposed conciliation agreement was sent to the respondent on October 25, 1979.

Evidence

On August 14, 1979, Jack Felzer, Treasurer of the Kane for Congress Committee responded to the Commission's reason to believe notification. He provided some additional contributor information; however the complete name, address, occupation, and principal place of business was lacking for approximately 70% of the contributors. Mr. Felzer did not respond to subsequent calls requesting more complete information. On November 27 and 29, 1979, Mr. Felzer responded to the Commission's reasonable cause to believe notification. Mr. Felzer reported the proceeds of the fundraising dinner as requested, and he provided additional addresses for contributors listed on the 30 Day Post-General Election Report. Although we still do not have the occupation

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and principal place of business for approximately 50% of the contributors, we now have complete names and mailing addresses for 99% of the contributors. Mr. Felzer has stated that he is attempting, with difficulty, to obtain the additional information.

Analysis

The recommendation from this Office to proceed to reasonable cause to believe and conciliation was based on the Kane Committee's failure to provide: (a) additional contributor information or an explanation of their best efforts to obtain that information; and (b) information on the September, 1978 fundraising dinner held at Helen Wilson's L'Abuberge restaurant. Mr. Felzer has now provided the information on the fundraising dinner, and although some contributor information is still lacking as explained above, he has shown his attempts to obtain that information. It appears that the conciliation process should be terminated, and that no further action should be taken against the Kane Committee in connection with this matter.

Recommendation

Take no further action against the Kane Committee in connection with a possible violation of 2 U.S.C. §434. Send the attached letter. Close the file.

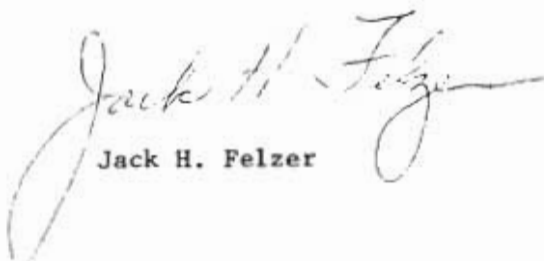

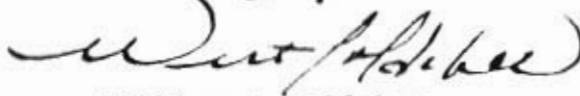

Specifically, the Commission found reasonable cause to believe that your committee omitted contributor information on its 1978 30 Day Post-General Election Report; and failed to provide the required information on a fundraising dinner.

The Commission has a duty to attempt to correct such violations for a period of 30 days by informal methods of conference, conciliation and persuasion, and by entering into a conciliation agreement. 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(B). If we are unable to reach an agreement during that period, the Commission may, upon a finding of probable cause to believe a violation has occurred, institute civil suit in United States District Court and seek payment of a civil penalty not in excess of \$5000.

CONCILIATION AGREEMENT

This matter having been initiated by a signed, sworn, and notarized complaint, an investigation having been conducted, and reasonable cause to believe having been found that Kane for Congress Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 by failing to provide required contributor information on its 1978 30 Day Post-General Election Report, and failing to provide the required information on a fundraising dinner.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission and Respondent, having duly entered into conciliation pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5), do hereby agree as follows:

I. The Commission has jurisdiction over the Respondent and the subject matter of this proceeding.

II. Respondent has had a reasonable opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken in this matter.

III. Respondent enters voluntarily into this agreement with the Commission.

IV. The pertinent facts in this matter are as follows:

A. Respondent is the principal campaign committee for Eugene Kane, a 1978 Republican candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives from the Seventh District of Pennsylvania.

B. 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. § 104.2(b)(2) require that the full name, address, occupation and principal place of business of each person who contributes in excess of \$100 during a reporting period must be disclosed.

C. 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. § 104.2(b)(6) require that the total amount of proceeds from the sale of tickets to each dinner, luncheon, rally and other fundraising event ... and mass collections made at these events, must be reported.

D. The Kane for Congress Committee omitted the complete name, address, occupation and principal place of business for approximately 70 percent of its contributors on its 1978 30 Day Post-General Election Report.

E. The Kane for Congress Committee failed to provide any information on the sale of tickets or main collections at a fundraising dinner held at Helen Wilson's L'Auberge which was reported on the October 10, 1978, Quarterly Report.

WHEREFORE, Respondent agrees:

V. Respondent violated 2 U.S.C. § 434, 11 C.F.R. § 104.2 and 11 C.F.R. § 104.2(b)(2) for failing to disclose required information on its Reports of Receipts and Expenditures.

VI. Respondent will disclose the required information on contributions and a fundraising dinner in an amended report to be filed with the Commission.

VI. Respondent will pay a civil penalty to the Treasurer of the United States in the amount of \$500.00, pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437(g) (a) (6) (B).

VII. Respondent agrees that it shall not undertake any activity which is in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, 2 U.S.C. § 431, et seq.

GENERAL CONDITIONS

IX. The Commission, on request of anyone filing a complaint under 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) concerning the matters at issue herein or on its own motion, may review compliance with this agreement. If the Commission believes that this agreement or any requirement thereof has been violated, it may institute a civil action for relief in the United States District Court for the District of Columbia.

X. It is mutually agreed that this agreement shall become effective as of the date that all parties hereto have executed same and the Commission has approved the entire agreement.

XI. It is agreed that respondent shall have no more than thirty (30) days from the date this agreement becomes effective to comply with and implement the requirement contained in this agreement and to so notify the Commission.

Find REASONABLE CAUSE TO BELIEVE that the Kane for Congress Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 by omitting contributor information from its 30 Day Post-General Election Report and for failing to provide the required information on a fundraising dinner. Send the letter and conciliation agreement attached to the General Counsel's Report dated October 3, 1979.

GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

Allegation:

Based on a complaint filed by John M. Gallagher, Jr., Chairman of the Edgar for Congress Committee, the Commission, on July 2, 1979, found reason to believe that the Cobblestone Association of Delaware County ("Cobblestone Association") may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434; and reason to believe that the Kane for Congress Committee ("Kane Committee") may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 and § 441a(f).

On August 2, 1979, the Cobblestone Association responded to the allegation that they failed to register and file reports with the Commission in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434. The Association stated that they were a non-partisan group and they had not sponsored a fundraiser for Eugene Kane as alleged by the complainant. Therefore, it does not appear that the Cobblestone Association violated 2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434 by failing to register and report with the Commission.

On August 14, 1979, Jack Felzer, Treasurer of the Kane for Congress Committee responded to the Commission's reason to believe notification. Mr. Felzer adequately answered questions concerning

accounting services provided by Murray Felzer and Jack Felzer; however, he did not provide information concerning a fundraising dinner as requested.

The Commission had also requested that Felzer provide complete names, addresses, occupation and principal place of business for the contributors listed on the 30 Day Post-General Election Report. Mr. Felzer filed an amended report; however the complete information is still lacking for approximately 70 percent of the contributors.

Following review of the amended report filed in August, 1979, several telephone conversations have been held between Mr. Felzer and the Office of General Counsel, and Mr. Felzer has promised to furnish the requested information. It was explained to Mr. Felzer that an explanation of his best efforts to obtain the contributor information could possibly satisfy the Commission's reporting requirement; however, as of this date no further information on contributors or best efforts has been received. It appears that the Commission should proceed further against the Kane Committee.

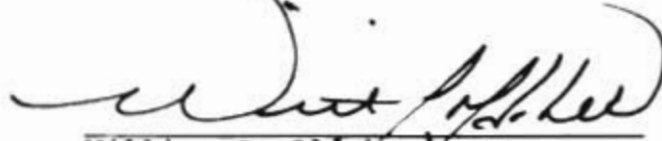
RECOMMENDATION

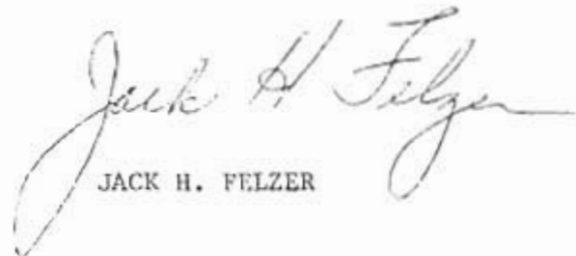

On October , 1979, the Commission determined there was reasonable cause to believe that your committee committed a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434 of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Specifically, the Commission found reasonable cause to believe that your committee omitted contributor information on its 1978 30 Day Post-General Election Report; and failed to provide the required information on a fundraising dinner.

The Commission has a duty to attempt to correct such violations for a period of 30 days by informal methods of conference, conciliation and persuasion, and by entering into a conciliation agreement. 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(5)(B). If we are unable to reach an agreement during that period, the Commission may, upon a finding of probable cause to believe a violation has occurred, institute civil suit in United States District Court and seek payment of a civil penalty not in excess of \$5000.

We enclose a conciliation agreement that this office is prepared to recommend to the Commission in settlement of this matter. If you agree with the provisions of the enclosed conciliation agreement, please sign and return it along with the civil penalty to the Commission within ten days. I will then recommend that the Commission approve the agreement.

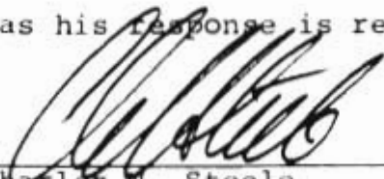

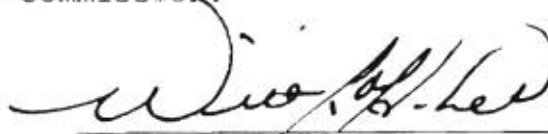

Additionally, the Commission should find reason to believe that the Kane for Congress Committee may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(f) for accepting an excessive contribution from Murray Felzer.
6. Find reason to believe that the Kane for Congress Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. §104.2(b)(6) for failing to provide the required information on a fundraising dinner.
7. Send the letter to the Kane for Congress Committee attached to the above-named report.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

John M. Gallagher, Jr., Chairman of the Edgar for Congress Committee (Pa.-7), filed a complaint, dated May 18, 1979 (Attachment I), alleging that:

1. The Cobblestone Association of Delaware County has not filed reports with the Commission although they sponsored a fundraiser and newsletters in support of Eugene D. Kane, the Republican Candidate who was defeated by Congressman Robert Edgar in the 1978 election.

2. The Greek-American Committee to Elect Kane to Congress financed a mailing and newspaper advertisement in support of Kane, but the Committee has filed no reports of receipts and expenditures with the Commission in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434.

3. The Kane for Congress Committee, in their October 10, 1978, Quarterly report, listed unitemized contributions from 48 individuals totaling \$1,473 on Schedule A instead of line 14B of the Detailed Summary Report.

4. The Kane for Congress Committee, on their 30 Day Post-General Election Report, omitted the full name, mailing address, occupation and principal place of business for many of its contributors in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434.

5. The Kane for Congress Committee, on their October 10, 1978, Quarterly report, shows a \$785 in-kind contribution from Murray A. Felzer, for "accounting, postage and telephone use." On the 30 Day Post-General Election Report, Mr. Felzer is credited with an in-kind contribution of \$600 for "accounting." It is alleged that Mr. Felzer has exceeded his \$1,000 contribution limitation to the Kane for Congress Committee.

6. The Kane for Congress Committee, on their October 10, 1978, Quarterly report, shows a \$2,013 expenditure to Helen Wilson's L'Auberge for a "fund raising dinner;" however, there is no schedule D attached to the report for further information on the dinner.

EVIDENCE AND ANALYSIS

1. No reports have been filed with the Commission by the Cobblestone Association of Delaware County. 2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434 require that each political committee which makes expenditures exceeding \$1,000 shall file a statement of organization and reports of receipts and expenditures with the Commission. 2 U.S.C. § 434(e) requires every person who makes independent expenditures in excess of \$100 to file with the Commission. If the Cobblestone Association of Delaware County spent over \$1,000 on the alleged fundraiser for Eugene Kane, or if the Association made independent expenditures in excess of \$100, they must register and report with the Commission.

2. The Greek-American Committee to Elect Kane to Congress registered with the Commission and filed a 1978 Year-End Report which disclosed mailing and advertising expenditures.

3. The Reports Analyst who reviewed the Kane for Congress Committee reports regards their reporting of unitemized contributions on Schedule A to be acceptable. The Committee should be notified of their error; however, in absence of any other evidence, the reporting of \$1,473 in unitemized contributions from 48 individuals on Schedule A does not indicate a violation of the Committee's reporting requirements.

4. The Reports Analysis Division sent an RFAI to the Kane for Congress Committee on June 1, 1979, for their omission of full name, address, occupation and principal place of business for many of their contributors on the 30 Day Post-General Election Report. The contributor information is required by 11 C.F.R. § 104.2(b)(2). The Committee did not respond to the RFAI and was called by the Reports Analysis Division on June 13, 1979. Jack Felzer, Treasurer of Kane for Congress, stated that he would respond within ten days.

5. The Reports Analysis Division sent an RFAI and subsequently an RTB notification (March 16, 1979) (Attachment II) to the Kane for Congress Committee for further information on the \$785 in-kind contribution from Murray A. Felzer which is required by 11 C.F.R. § 110.1(e). This in-kind contribution was reported on the October 10, 1978, Quarterly Report (Attachment III). In a telephone conversation on June 13, 1979, Jack Felzer stated that he would provide the additional information within ten days. It appears that the Committee should also provide an explanation of Murray Felzer's subsequent \$600 in-kind contribution for "accounting" (Attachment IV). If these accounting services were for the purpose of ensuring compliance with the Federal Election Campaign Act, they are not considered contributions as set out in 2 U.S.C. § 431(e).

6. 11 C.F.R. § 104.2(b)(6) states that the total amount of proceeds from the sale of tickets to each dinner, luncheon, rally and other fund-raising event ... and mass collection made at these events, must be reported. It appears that the Kane for Congress Committee must disclose further information on the fundraising dinner held at Helen Wilson's L'Auberge which was reported on the October 10, 1978, Quarterly Report.

RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Find reason to believe that the Cobblestone Association of Delaware County may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 433 and § 434 for failure to file reports with the Commission. Send the attached letter.
2. Find no reason to believe that the Greek-American Committee to Elect Kane to Congress violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 for failing to file reports with the Commission. Send the attached letter.
3. Find no reason to believe that the Kane for Congress Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 for incorrectly reporting unitemized contributions.
4. Find reason to believe that the Kane for Congress Committee omitted contributor information from its 30 Day Post-General Election Report in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 434.
5. The Commission on March 16, 1979, found reason to believe that the Kane for Congress Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 for failing to provide information regarding a \$785 in-kind contribution from Murray Felzer. Additionally, the Commission should find reason to believe that the Kane for Congress Committee may have violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(f) for accepting an excessive contribution from Murray Felzer.
6. Find reason to believe that the Kane for Congress Committee violated 2 U.S.C. § 434 and 11 C.F.R. § 104.2(b)(6) for failing to provide the required information on a fundraising dinner.

Gentlemen:

I am writing to you concerning several reporting violations which the treasurer of the Edgar for Congress Committee, Walter Pierzchalla, has noted in the filings of the Kane for Congress Committee, and certain other political committees who made expenditures on behalf of Mr. Kane's unsuccessful bid to unseat Congressman Robert Edgar in the 1978 Congressional election for the 7th District of Pennsylvania.

First, we note that, although Mr. Kane had indirect contributions from several organizations, none of these organizations filed as required by the Federal Election Law. Specifically, one group known as the Cobblestone Association of Delaware County, P.O. Box 344, Lansdowne, Pennsylvania 19050, whose self-avowed purpose for several years now has been to unseat Representative Edgar, publish several newsletters inviting the public to political events touting Mr. Kane's candidacy and attacking Congressman Edgar. This organization sponsored a fall dinner meeting which appears to have been a fund raiser, and which took place on Tuesday, September 26, 1978 at the Lafayette Room at the Holiday Inn in Lima, Pennsylvania. A charge of \$7.50 per person was made for this dinner. We do not have any knowledge of the exact activities of the Cobblestone Association because that Association has filed no information with the FEC. My question to the FEC is whether or not an organization such as the Cobblestone Association is required to file anything, or register at all with the FEC.

A much more obvious violation of Federal Campaign Laws has been perpetrated by the bi-partisan Greek-American Committee to Elect Kane to Congress, ID No. C-00105494. This organization registered with the FEC, but filed no report. We know that this Committee should have filed a report because it not only incurred the expense of at least one rather widely distributed mailing, but it also took out at least one newspaper advertisement, printed in Greek, advocating Mr. Kane's election and Mr. Edgar's defeat. It is possible, of course, that all of their activity was done on a budget of less than \$1,000.00; however, this seems extremely unlikely to me. I feel that the Federal Election Commission should investigate the activity of this committee, to see if there has been any violation of Federal Law as a result of the Committee's failure to file.

Mr. Kane's own reports are so insufficient and so replete with misinformation that it is very difficult to ascertain the full extent of what violations of the Federal Election Law Mr. Kane's committee may have committed. I would like to list the shortcomings of the report and apparent violations, going through the reports chronologically, as follows:

1. On the October 10 Quarterly Report, on Page 1 of Schedule A, "Itemized Receipts", the Treasurer of the Kane for Congress Committee erroneously reports unitemized contributions from 48 individuals amounting to \$1,473.00. The problem here is that such a substantial amount of money, could include contributions from a single individual exceeding \$100.00, in which case, of course, the individual's name, address and occupation should be set forth. However, when Mr. Kane reports unitemized contributions on Schedule A, if any of those contributions are in excess of \$100.00, he has a colorable argument that he was attempting to comply with the disclosure requirements by putting them on Schedule A. These itemized contributions should be removed to Line 14B of the Detailed Summary Report or the names addresses and occupations of the individuals should be reported in Schedule A--not a combination of the two.

2. Throughout the reports, Mr. Kane fails to set forth the occupation of many of his contributors. Indeed, in many cases a contributor is identified only by name, or by name and community.

3. In the October 10 Quarterly Report on Page 1 of Schedule A, Itemized Receipts, reporting in-kind

contributions, a contribution from Murray A. Felzer, for accounting, postage and telephone use, amounting to \$785.00 is reported. Unfortunately, no date for this contribution is mentioned; however, since it was not reported on previous reports, it presumably had to have been made during the general election. On the 30-day Post-General Election Report, Mr. Murray Felzer is again credited with an in-kind contribution, this time in the amount of \$600.00 for "accounting". This, of course, puts Murray Felzer \$385.00 above the maximum allowable contributions for the General Election permitted by any individual. This is a violation of the Federal Law that appears right on the records filed by the Kane for Congress Committee and yet no action that I know of has been taken against Murray Felzer or the Kane for Congress Committee for this violation.

4. Again on the October 10 Quarterly Report, the Kane Committee lists on Schedule B itemized expenditures, Page 6, an expense of \$2,013.10 paid to Helen Wilson's "L'Auberge" restaurant for a fund raising dinner on September 14, 1978. However, neither this report or any of Mr. Kane's other reports list any proceeds from that dinner. An explanation of this discrepancy is in order.

As I mentioned earlier, it is impossible for us to tell whether there are any definite violations (other than the violations involving Murray Felzer, which I indicated above), because of the sloppy reporting done by Mr. Kane's Committee. In many cases, a contributor is identified only by name. In most cases during the general election reporting period, contributions and expenditures are not identified by date. Because of the consistency of these failures, we feel that Mr. Kane's Committee should be directed by the Federal Election Commission to completely revise all of its reports, with all required data set forth. We also feel that you should look into the irregularities and discrepancies listed above.

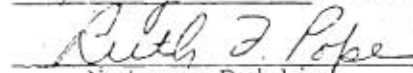

The Federal Election Commission has received a complaint which alleges that the Cobblestone Association of Delaware County, ("the Association") committed certain violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). We have numbered this matter MUR 981. The Commission has reason to believe that the matters alleged therein state a violation of 2 U.S.C. §433 and §434.

Specifically, 2 U.S.C. §433 and §434 require that each political committee which makes expenditures exceeding \$1,000 shall file a statement of organization and reports of receipts and expenditures with the Commission. In addition, 2 U.S.C. §434(e) requires every person who makes independent expenditures in excess of \$100 to file with the Commission. It has been alleged that the Association sponsored a fundraiser and sent out newsletters in support of Eugene D. Kane, and therefore is required to file with the Commission. A copy of the Act and its Regulations are enclosed for your information.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you. Please submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's analysis of this matter. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

The Commission is under a duty to investigate this matter expeditiously. Therefore, your response should be submitted within ten days after your receipt of this notification.

The Federal Election Commission has received a complaint which alleges that your committee, Kane for Congress, has violated certain provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). We have numbered this matter MUR 981.

On 1979, the Commission determined there was reason to believe that your committee may have violated 2 U.S.C. §434 and §441a(f). Specifically:

- 1) On the 30 Day Post-General Election Report (1978), your committee omitted full name, address, occupation and principal place of business for many of its contributors in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434 and 11 C.F.R. §104.2(b)(2).
- 2) Your committee has failed to provide complete information regarding two in-kind contributions from Murray Felzer in amounts of \$785 and \$600. This information is required by 2 U.S.C. §434 and 11 C.F.R. §110.1(e).
- 3) It appears that your committee may have accepted a contribution in excess of \$1,000 from Murray Felzer in violation of 2 U.S.C. §431(e).
- 4) Your committee has failed to report the proceeds of a fundraising dinner at Helen Wilson's



L'Auberge in violation of 2 U.S.C. §434 and 11 C.F.R. §104.2(b)(6).

In addition, the Commission would like to call your attention to the fact that unitemized contributions are to be reported on line 14B of the Detailed Summary Page of your reports.

Under the Act, you have an opportunity to demonstrate that no action should be taken against you. Please submit any factual or legal materials which you believe are relevant to the Commission's analysis of this matter. Additionally, please submit answers to the enclosed questions. Where appropriate, statements should be submitted under oath.

The Commission is under a duty to investigate this matter expeditiously. Therefore, your response should be submitted within ten days after your receipt of this notification.

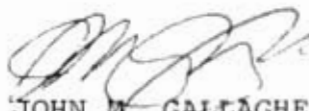

Gentlemen:

I am writing to you concerning several reporting violations which the treasurer of the Edgar for Congress Committee, Walter Pierzchalla, has noted in the filings of the Kane for Congress Committee, and certain other political committees who made expenditures on behalf of Mr. Kane's unsuccessful bid to unseat Congressman Robert Edgar in the 1978 Congressional election for the 7th District of Pennsylvania.

First, we note that, although Mr. Kane had indirect assistance from several organizations, none of these organizations filed as required by the Federal Election Law. Specifically, one group known as the Cobblestone Association of Delaware County, P.O. Box 344, Lansdowne, Pennsylvania 19050, whose self-avowed purpose for several years now has been to unseat Representative Edgar, publish several newsletters inviting the public to political events touting Mr. Kane's candidacy and attacking Congressman Edgar. This organization sponsored a fall dinner meeting which appears to have been a fund raiser, and which took place on Tuesday, September 26, 1978 at the Lafayette Room at the Holiday Inn in Lima, Pennsylvania. A charge of \$7.50 per person was made for this dinner. We do not have any knowledge of the exact activities of the Cobblestone Association because that Association has filed no information with the FEC. My question to the FEC is whether or not an organization such as the Cobblestone Association is required to file anything, or register at all with the FEC.

A much more obvious violation of Federal Campaign Laws has been perpetrated by the bi-partisan Greek-American Committee to Elect Kane to Congress, ID No. C-00105494. This organization registered with the FEC, but filed no report. We know that this Committee should have filed a report because it not only incurred the expense of at least one rather widely distributed mailing, but it also took out at least one newspaper advertisement, printed in Greek, advocating Mr. Kane's election and Mr. Edgar's defeat. It is possible, of course, that all of their activity was done on a budget of less than \$1,000.00; however, this seems extremely unlikely to me. I feel that the Federal Election Commission should investigate the activity of this committee, to see if there has been any violation of Federal Law as a result of the Committee's failure to file.

Mr. Kane's own reports are so insufficient and so replete with misinformation that it is very difficult to ascertain the full extent of what violations of the Federal Election Law Mr. Kane's committee may have committed. I would like to list the shortcomings of the report and apparent violations, going through the reports chronologically, as follows:

1. On the October 10 Quarterly Report, on Page 1 of Schedule A, "Itemized Receipts", the Treasurer of the Kane for Congress Committee erroneously reports unitemized contributions from 48 individuals amounting to \$1,473.00. The problem here is that such a substantial amount of money, could include contributions from a single individual exceeding \$100.00, in which case, of course, the individual's name, address and occupation should be set forth. However, when Mr. Kane reports unitemized contributions on Schedule A, if any of these contributions are in excess of \$100.00, he has a colorable argument that he was attempting to comply with the disclosure requirements by putting them on Schedule A. These itemized contributions should be removed to Line 14B of the Detailed Summary Report or the names addresses and occupations of the individuals should be reported in Schedule A--not a combination of the two.

2. Throughout the reports, Mr. Kane fails to set forth the occupation of many of his contributors. Indeed, in many cases a contributor is identified only by name, or by name and community.

3. In the October 10 Quarterly Report on Page 1 of Schedule A, Itemized Receipts, reporting in-kind

contributions, a contribution from Murray A. Felzer, for accounting, postage and telephone use, amounting to \$785.00 is reported. Unfortunately, no date for this contribution is mentioned; however, since it was not reported on previous reports, it presumably had to have been made during the general election. On the 30-day Post-General Election Report, Mr. Murray Felzer is again credited with an in-kind contribution, this time in the amount of \$600.00 for "accounting". This, of course, puts Murray Felzer \$385.00 above the maximum allowable contributions for the General Election permitted by any individual. This is a violation of the Federal Law that appears right on the records filed by the Kane for Congress Committee and yet no action that I know of has been taken against Murray Felzer or the Kane for Congress Committee for this violation.

4. Again on the October 10 Quarterly Report, the Kane Committee lists on Schedule B itemized expenditures, Page 6, an expense of \$2,013.10 paid to Helen Wilson's "L'Auberge" restaurant for a fund raising dinner on September 14, 1978. However, neither this report or any of Mr. Kane's other reports list any proceeds from that dinner. An explanation of this discrepancy is in order.

As I mentioned earlier, it is impossible for us to tell whether there are any definite violations (other than the violations involving Murray Felzer, which I indicated above), because of the sloppy reporting done by Mr. Kane's Committee. In many cases, a contributor is identified only by name. In most cases during the general election reporting period, contributions and expenditures are not identified by date. Because of the consistency of these failures, we feel that Mr. Kane's committee should be directed by the Federal Election Commission to completely refile all of its reports, with all required data set forth. We also feel that you should look into the irregularities and discrepancies listed above.
