Dear FEC Complaints Investigator Jordan:

This is Andrew Straw and I made a complaint against Mr. Pete DiCianni for a number of violations of the laws and rules regarding fundraising for a federal U.S. House candidate in the 8th District of Illinois. Complaint# MUR 6970

1. Mr. DiCianni asked me to leave the race for his benefit on June 19, 2015 at Panera in Streamwood, IL. He was at a minimum "testing the waters" from that time forward. Once he reached \$5,000 in fundraising or expenditures after that, he should have filed an FEC report. In fact, he had over \$5,000 in fundraising in June before the June 30 deadline and after June 19, and over \$5,000 in fundraising in the 3rd quarter also.

As you know, he filed no FEC campaign finance report in Q2 or Q3. I am including his Q2 and Q3 reports to the Illinois State Board of Elections, and these show what I believe are prohibited corporate, union, and national bank contributions in both quarters.

2. Immediately after the June 19 meeting, he received a number of donations directly from corporations, a union, and a national bank in his local fundraising account.

3. His expenditures in the state reports show that he was using these funds for the federal race. One example clearly showing this is on page 7 of his Q3 report. He spent \$500 of this mixed, prohibited funds to secure a tent at the 35th Annual Northwest Suburban Republican Family Picnic. I made a PDF of the webpage for this event today and it shows DiCianni's federal campaign logo as was used for that event. This shows that he has been using his local account for illegal purposes, since he has illegal campaign contributions in the account for federal purposes, and he has been using the money to help his federal campaign.

He has a large number of contributions to candidates for other offices inside the district, as well as marketing and other expenses clearly for the federal campaign, to gather support for himself.

DiCianni has been a candidate since June 19 at a minimum. He has collected over \$25,000 in donations since that time. Many of these sources are prohibited under the law. He spent that money, prohibited funds, on expenses for his federal campaign.

DiCianni has reported \$0 to the FEC in donations or expenditures in both Q2 and Q3, filing no report whatsoever.

Thank you for further investigating these additional information regarding DiCianni's disregard of the FEC rules and the law, as laid out in the candidate manual. He appears to be attempting to hide his fundraising and expenditures from the FEC, while doing things that are illegal.

Finally, I would draw your attention to the money he raised from the "Coalition for Better Government" on page 5 of the report.

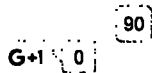

Without Clout, 'Little Guy' A Perfect Daley Scapegoat

It's as if Mayor Richard Daley's administration is starting to resemble the cast of a Quentin Tarantino movie.

Think of the City Hall tough guys you read about last week. Imagine them at an all-night snack [shop](#) near Harlem and Irving at 2 a.m., drinking coffee, telling jokes, ordering the rice pudding, calling the waitress "honey."

There's the one who acts like a cop and likes to carry a tiny gun in his pants. There's the armored [car](#) thief who did three years in federal prison. There's the tough vote fraud king who bosses city truck [drivers](#) around. And the disbarred lawyer, ghost payroller and tax cheat.

One problem. It's not a movie.

Your city property taxes pay their salaries at Chicago's City Hall. They call themselves the Coalition For Better Government, and they're Ronnie Calicchio's crew.

The mayor needs them working the precincts for his re-election, so he has nothing to say. He might even be afraid of them.

But there's other people he's not afraid of. They're the city workers who have to worry. They're the little people, tiny guys he can scream at and destroy.

Guys like Jim McTigue, the fall guy for the Great Chicago Flood of 1992.

"I didn't have a chance," McTigue told me the other day, after the Illinois Appellate Court ruled he was wrongfully fired by the mayor six years ago.

"I don't have clout like those guys you've been writing about.

That's the difference.

"Daley called me a liar on the national news. He called me lazy. And I never met the man. All I knew was that I was a little guy and they were going to protect their people and blame me," McTigue said.

"He made my life a living hell for six years. We had hard, tough times. Put yourself in my place: You're in construction and the mayor's screaming at you. What company [↗](#) wants to hire you after that?"

With three kids and medical bills and a mortgage, the Marine Corps Vietnam combat veteran had to cash in his city pension. He delivered pizzas and scrambled at odd jobs, finally hooking up with a surveying company.

His union, the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees [↗](#) Council 31, got him a lawyer [↗](#).

"The administration made him a scapegoat," said Henry Bayer, executive director [↗](#) of AFSCME. "That's what happened to Jim McTigue."

Remember the political sequence. The crack in an underground freight tunnel below the Chicago River was discovered by the city and ignored. It finally broke open. The tunnel flooded.

Downtown was swamped. And the mayor's bureaucrats, the guys on his political team, began a mad rush to cover their behinds with dispensable workers.

A few days later, Daley passed sentence in his press briefing room on the 5th Floor of City Hall. Like a mad Balkan prince, he impaled about eight of them.

One was an almost bigshot, then acting Transportation Department Commissioner John LaPlante, who had served under Daley's arch enemy, former Mayor Jane Byrne. LaPlante's politics were suspect, so he was expendable and fired.

McTigue was the smallest fry and was blamed for ignoring the problem when he found a crack in a tunnel. He was blamed for leaving photos of the tunnel breach at a neighborhood drugstore. The mayor publicly peeled his skin.

What we didn't know at the time was that McTigue immediately had told his bosses about the tunnel problem. He told his supervisor, Al Mourillon, a former construction engineer who worked in the Department of General Services [↗](#). Mourillon said later that he told his boss, then General Services

Commissioner Ben Reyes.

"I told him there might be some problem in the tunnel," Mourillon said a week or so after the flood. "I talked to Reyes. We did exactly what we were supposed to do. He, McTigue, reported it to me, and I told the commissioner."

Reyes maintained that nobody told him and hasn't budged from his story. At the time, he was a key Daley link to Latino political circles. Now he's the Public Building Commissioner, which makes him a king of real estate in Chicago.

And McTigue? He's waiting to see what the city lawyers will do. They have about a month to appeal the case.

If they don't, there will be a city personnel board hearing and McTigue will try to recoup the \$250,000 in back pay he figures the mayor owes him. If there is a hearing, I'll let you know when and where.

"I told you the last time I saw you, I wouldn't let them make me the Mrs. O'Leary's cow of the flood," McTigue said, laughing about his 1992 quote that made the quote of the year lists. "And I won't."

It's an old lesson of the ways of clout, the threads that bind Chicago's political life.

Too bad Jim McTigue and his three kids had to pay for it.

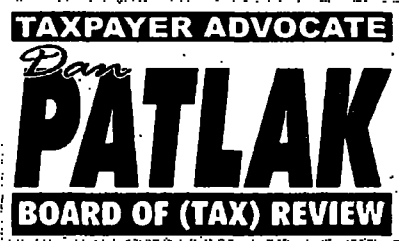

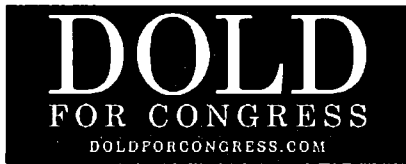
