Re: Complaint Against Kyle Foust Exploratory Committee

Dear Ms. Duncan:

The Eric County Republican Party, by and through Chairman Brad Moore, hereby brings this complaint pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(1) against the Kyle Foust Exploratory Committee.

Kyle Foust is a potential candidate for the United States Congress from the 3<sup>rd</sup> Congressional District of Pennsylvania. He has established an exploratory committee, the Kyle Foust Exploratory Committee ("Foust Committee") and is soliciting contributions and making expenditures on behalf of his campaign. The Kyle Foust Exploratory Committee is not registered with the Federal Election Commission ("FEC" or "Commission").

The Foust Committee recently paid for a mail piece stating his decision to form an exploratory committee to "gauge the viability of [his] candidacy" for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Congressional District. (Attachment 1, Kyle Foust Exploratory Committee Letter). The mail piece contains a solicitation for contributions and instructs recipients to learn more about his background on his County Council Re-Election website.

As explained below, there are at least three violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended by the Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act of 2002 ("the Act") and FEC regulations, including:

- The use of his county council reelection website to campaign for federal office
- Failure to place a box around the "paid for by" portion of the disclaimer
- The omission of the required IRS disclaimer
- 1. Use of County Council Reelection Website to Promote Federal Campaign

Kyle Foust's mail piece directs individuals to "visit [his] County Council Re-Election website at <a href="https://www.kylefoust.com">www.kylefoust.com</a>" in order to learn more about him. This is a blatant violation of the Act and FEC regulations.

Federal candidates, including individuals who are "testing the waters" may only raise and spend funds subject to the federal contribution limitation requirements; *i.e.*, \$2,300 per election from individuals and nonmulticandidate PACs, and \$5,000 per election from multicandidate PACs. 11 C.F.R. § 100.72(a) and 100.131(a). Moreover, the Act and FEC regulations specifically prohibit a candidate from transferring funds from a campaign committee for a nonfederal election to a campaign committee for a federal election. 11 C.F.R. § 110.3(d).

This is exactly what Foust has done. Foust is using his county council re-election website to promote his federal campaign, and by doing so, is using contributions raised in a nonfederal campaign for a federal campaign. This is in direct violation of the Act and FEC regulations.

## 2. Failure to Follow FEC and IRS Disclaimer Requirements

a. <u>Disclaimer must be within a printed box</u>: Federal committees are required to place disclaimers on public communications stating who actually paid for the communication. In printed communications, the disclaimer must be set off in a printed box, and the text must be of a sufficient size to be "clearly readable" to the recipient. There must also be a reasonable degree of color contrast between the text of the communication and the background. 11 C.F.R. § 110.11(c)(2)(ii), (iii). A disclaimer in 12 point font printed in black on a white background will meet the FEC's safe harbor requirement.

The Kyle Foust mailing failed to put the "Paid for by" disclaimer in a printed box as required by FEC regulations. This is in direct violation of the bright-line regulations governing disclaimers and has been taken seriously by the Commission. For example, the Commission recently fined the Martin Frost Campaign Committee \$6,000 for failure to place the box around the disclaimer on three commercial mailings, even thought the disclaimer was printed correctly. See MUR 5547.

## b. Failure to Comply with IRS Notice Requirements

The Internal Revenue Code requires political committees whose gross annual receipts exceed \$100,000 to include a notice that informs contributors that contributions are not tax deductible. 26 U.S.C. § 6113. This requirement is enforced by the IRS and failure to comply may result in substantial penalties. The IRS notice is usually placed on all solicitations to ensure contributors are aware that their contributions are not tax deductible.

While the FEC is not ultimately responsible for enforcing this requirement, the Foust campaign's failure to include this disclaimer illustrates the campaign's disregard and indifference to the Act, FEC regulations and guidance offered by the Commission.

## 3. Conclusion

We respectfully request that the Commission find reason to believe that Federal law has been violated and take the appropriate legal action.

The foregoing is correct and accurate to the best of my knowledge, information and belief.


