Lawrence M. Noble has served as General Counsel to the Federal Election Commission since October 1987.

Mr. Noble's other duties at the Commission have included serving as Acting General Counsel, Deputy General Counsel and Assistant General Counsel for Litigation.

Prior to joining the FEC, Mr. Noble was employed by the Aviation Consumer Action Project as an attorney.

Mr. Noble serves on the Executive Committee of the Election Law Committee of the Administrative Law Section of the American Bar Association and is a member of the Committee on Judicial Review of the Administrative Conference of the United States. He is admitted to practice before the District of Columbia Bar, the U.S. District Court for the District of Columbia, the United States Courts of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit, Fourth Circuit and Fifth Circuit, and the U.S. Supreme Court. Mr. Noble has been a participant in election observing and consulting delegations in the former Soviet Union, Benin, Senegal, and Mexico.

A recipient of a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from Syracuse University in 1973, Mr. Noble received his Juris Doctor from the National Law Center at George Washington University in 1976. In 1991 he attended the John F. Kennedy School of Government Program for Senior Managers in Government at Harvard University.
