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## DESCRIPTION OF REPORT

## SCOPE:

The "FEC Reports on Financial Activity--Presidential Pre-Nomination Campaigns" is a summary of the campaign finance activity of major Presidential candidates involved in the 1980 primary election process. Specifically this report provides information on the financial activity of the pre-nomination campaigns of those individuals who 1) have registered under the Federal Election Campaign Act as a candidate for nomination to the Office of President of the United States and 2) have reported total receipts or total disbursements in excess of \$100,000. The study also covers individuals on whose behalf draft committees have spent in excess of \$100,000.

The activity listed for each primary campaign includes all receipts and disbursements reported to the FEC by the Presidential candidates, their principal campaign committees and any other committees the candidates authorized for the 1980 primary election.

The report also covers activity undertaken on behalf of a primary candidate but which is not authorized by him/her. Such activity is shown under separate, specific columns. One column, for example, shows independent expenditures, while another displays communications costs.

## SOURCE OF INFORMATION:

Most of the information included in this report was taken from the reports filed, on FEC Form 3P (with supporting schedules), by the Presidential candidates and their authorized committees. However, that information pertaining to independent expenditures, delegate/delegate committee disbursements, unauthorized/draft

committee disbursements and communications costs was taken from reports submitted by persons engaged in these particular types of activity.

Information on receipts and disbursements from reports filed with the Commission was entered into the Commission's computer system. Programs that summarize this information were used to produce the TABLES included in this report.

Available for inspection at the Commission are microfilmed copies of the original reports filed with the Commission. The microfilmed public record is the official record of the Federal Election Commission.

## PERIOD COVERED:

This report covers the period beginning in 1978 when Presidential primary candidates first began filing campaign finance reports with the Commission. As subsequent reports pertaining to 1979-80 activity were received during 1979, 1980 and 1981, the dollar figures contained in them were entered into the computer system and added to earlier information.

The computer programs which produced the TABLES in this report were run on November 4, 1981 and used all the 1978-80 data which had been filed at the Commission by June 30, 1981. (Data in TABLE A4 on primary matching fund activity, however, is current through November 4, 1981.)

LIMITATIONS:

This report is a final report, designed to give a complete picture of the primary campaign which occurred during the 1978-80 period. It is possible, however, that the information contained in this report may be subsequently amended by the candidates and committees.

Available at the Commission for inspection are microfilmed copies of the original reports which show information as reported by the filers. The microfilmed public record is the official record of the Federal Election Commission. This report is one of several tools which have been developed to summarize the vast quantity of data available on the microfilmed public record.

## SUMMARY OF TABLES

The TABLES are designed to provide information on the financial activity of the pre-nomination campaigns included in this volume. The EXPLANATION OF COLUMNS provides detailed definitions of columns and explanations of organization; it should be used in conjunction with the TABLES.

**TABLES A1-A8 FINANCIAL ACTIVITY OF SELECTED PRESIDENTIAL PRE-NOMINATION CAMPAIGNS**

These eight TABLES provide receipt and disbursement information on the pre-nomination campaigns of those individuals who 1) have registered under the Federal Election Campaign Act as a candidate for nomination to the Office of President of the United States and 2) have reported total receipts or total disbursements in excess of \$100,000. These TABLES also cover individuals on whose behalf draft committees have spent in excess of \$100,000. The campaigns are divided into three categories: Democratic, Republican and Other. Within each category, the candidates' campaigns are listed alphabetically. The candidate's party affiliation is reported on his/her Statement of Candidate (FEC Form 2) filed with the Commission.

Total receipts and total disbursements are not necessarily accurate reflections of the actual money that is available to and spent by a primary campaign. These figures are frequently inflated due to the fact that they include transfers between filers within the same campaign (the candidate and the authorized committees). So that these internal transfers will not be

counted twice, they have been subtracted from total receipts and from total disbursements to provide adjusted figures: Net receipts and net disbursements. It is these two columns which most accurately depict receipts and disbursements.

**TABLE A1 RECEIPTS**

This TABLE divides TOTAL RECEIPTS into various subcategories such as REFUNDS/REBATES and OTHER INCOME.

**TABLE A2 CONTRIBUTIONS FROM INDIVIDUALS**

This TABLE shows a breakdown of the TOTAL INDIVIDUAL CONTRIBUTIONS to a campaign. The TABLE includes the total amount of unitemized contributions from individuals and itemized contributions from individuals. Also shown is the amount of individual itemized contributions which were refunded by the campaign.

**TABLE A3 CONTRIBUTIONS FROM POLITICAL COMMITTEES**

This TABLE shows details of net contributions which the campaign has received from party and non-party committees. The amount of net contributions from political committees is equal to total contributions from political committees minus itemized refunds of contributions which the campaign has made to party and non-party committees.

**TABLE A4 PRIMARY MATCHING FUND ACTIVITY**

This TABLE shows the primary matching fund certification activity for those campaigns receiving Federal matching funds.

**TABLE A5 CASH-ON-HAND AND DEBTS**

This TABLE shows figures for a campaign's "cash-on-hand" and debts.

TABLE A6 DISBURSEMENTS

This TABLE shows TOTAL DISBURSEMENTS, dividing them into several categories such as ITEMIZED LOAN REPAYMENTS TO THE CANDIDATE, and OPERATING EXPENDITURES and EXPENDITURES SUBJECT TO LIMIT. (Limits on expenditures apply only to campaigns that receive Federal matching funds.)

TABLE A7 EXPENDITURES, DISBURSEMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS COSTS BY OTHERS

This TABLE shows expenditures, disbursements and communications costs for and against the campaign, as reported by non-party committees and other persons filing reports with the Commission.

TABLE A8 STATE-BY-STATE EXPENDITURES

This TABLE shows, for campaigns that are eligible for matching payments, the state-by-state expenditures subject to limitations.

TABLE B NET RECEIPTS

This TABLE shows the relationship between the party affiliation of the campaign and the size of net receipts. The campaigns are divided into three categories: Democratic, Republican and Other. Within each category, the candidates' campaigns are listed alphabetically.

TABLE C NET DISBURSEMENTS

The TABLE shows the relationship between the party affiliation of the campaign and the size of net disbursements. TABLE C is identical in organization to TABLE B.

TABLE D CONTRIBUTIONS FROM INDIVIDUALS

This TABLE shows the relationship between the party affiliation of the campaign and the size of individual contributions. TABLE D is identical in organization to TABLE B.

TABLE E CONTRIBUTIONS FROM POLITICAL COMMITTEES

This table shows the relationship between the party affiliation of the campaign and the amount of support from 1) party committees and 2) different types of non-party committees, such as corporation-connected or labor-connected political committees. TABLE E is identical in organization to TABLE B.

TABLE F DATE OF CONTRIBUTIONS BY POLITICAL COMMITTEES

This TABLE shows, for each of the campaigns and for all campaigns taken together, the relationship between the party affiliation of the campaign, the date on which a contribution was received, and the amount of support from 1) party committees and 2) different types of non-party committees, such as corporation-connected or labor-connected political committees.

There is a separate page for each of the campaigns (see TABLE B for description), and one for all Presidential campaigns.

TABLE G INDIVIDUAL CONTRIBUTIONS AGGREGATED BY STATE

This TABLE shows the relationship between the party affiliation of the campaign and the state address of the individual contributor. Figures are given for itemized contributions from individuals of \$500-and-up. The campaigns (see TABLE B for description) are displayed individually; and a final column gives figures for all Presidential campaigns.

### III

#### EXPLANATION OF COLUMNS

This section explains the special terms that appear as labels of the different columns, how the amount is derived for each column and, where appropriate, the significance of the column. Words included in this section are listed in the order in which they appear in each table. For example, the column in TABLE A3, labeled NET PARTY CONTRIB, appears under TABLE A3, as the first entry. Readers are encouraged to consult this section regularly as they use the report.

Readers should be aware that the terms as used in this report may be defined differently than they are in the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

In addition to explaining terms, the EXPLANATION OF COLUMNS indicates the line number and (where appropriate) the schedule letter of the September 1978 FEC Form 3P on which the receipt and disbursement information was reported.

#### TABLE A1 - RECEIPTS

##### CANDIDATE:

TABLE A provides information on the pre-nomination campaigns of those individuals who 1) have registered under the Federal Election Campaign Act as a candidate for nomination to the Office of President of the United States and 2) have reported total receipts or total disbursements in excess of \$100,000. The TABLE also covers individuals on whose behalf draft committees have spent over \$100,000.

The candidates' campaigns are listed in alphabetical order within a party grouping. The candidate's party affiliation is reported on his/her Statement of Candidate (FEC Form 2) filed with the Commission.

##### TOTAL RECEIPTS:

This column includes all incoming monies, goods and services reported on Line 8, Column A, by the candidate and the committees he/she authorized for the 1980 primary election campaign. (It does not include receipts of campaign committees authorized by the candidate in conjunction with a previous or subsequent Federal election.)

##### NET RECEIPTS:

This column shows the actual receipts of the candidate and all the committees he/she has authorized for the 1980 primary campaign. It is equal to total receipts reported by those campaign committees and the candidate, minus any transfers they have received from each other. ("Transfers", reported on Line 18a or 18b of Schedule A, are the movement of money, goods, property or services between the candidate and his/her authorized committees or between those committees.) Note that, if a joint fundraising committee or a campaign committee that was authorized by the candidate for another Federal campaign transfers funds to a 1980 primary campaign committee, the transaction is regarded as a contribution from another non-campaign committee, not as an internal transfer. (Note that previous FEC studies used the word "transfer" to mean any contribution made to or by a political committee. Under this study, contributions received from political committees which are not part of the candidate's 1980 primary campaign are called "contributions".)

##### REFUNDS, REBATES:

The receipts given in this column represent all refunds, rebates, or returns of disbursements to the campaign. These incoming monies include such things as returns of deposits on office equipment. The amounts are reported on Line 21c, Column A.

EXEM FUND/LEGAL/ACCT REFUNDS REBATES (Refunds and Rebates Relating to Exempt Fundraising, Legal and Accounting Fees):

This column shows the total amount of refunds and rebates of disbursements made for certain fundraising, legal and accounting fees that are exempt from expenditure limitations. (See 2 U.S.C. §441a(b) and §431(9)(B)(vi) and (vii).) Information is reported on Line 22c, Column A. For example, if a campaign pays a consultant \$10,000 to conduct fundraising, the amount is exempt from the expenditure limit as long as it does not exceed 20 percent of that limit. If the consultant refunds \$3,000 of the original payment, that amount would be included in this column.

**FEDERAL MATCHING FUNDS:**

This column shows the amount of Federal matching funds certified by the FEC and received by the candidate during 1980 from the U.S. Treasury, as reported by the campaign on Line 16, Column A on 1980 disclosure reports. (Note that the amount shown here may be less than the TOTAL AMOUNT CERTIFIED TO DATE given on p. 5 of this volume, as the latter figure may reflect amounts certified by the Commission during 1981.)

This figure represents all itemized and unitemized contributions from individuals, as reported on Line 17d, Column A, minus any itemized contributions of \$101 and above made by the candidate to his campaign. (Checks for individual contributions that banks returned to the campaign because of "non-sufficient funds" have been reported, by some campaigns, as negative receipts and thus netted out of the total individual contribution amount.) As used in this study, contributions from individuals include monies

given to the campaign or earmarked through another political committee and in-kind contributions of services, goods or property. (Note that itemized loans received from individuals are shown under the column labeled ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS and un-itemized loans from individuals are included under the column labeled MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**CONTRIB FROM CANDIDATE:**

The figure is the sum of itemized \$101-and-above contributions from the candidate to his campaign. Such contributions, reported on Line 17a, Schedule A, may be either cash or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property. (Note that itemized loans received from the candidate are shown under the column ITEMIZED LOANS FROM CANDIDATE and unitemized loans from the candidate are included under the column labeled MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**TOTAL PARTY CONTRIB:**

The amount given here is the sum of all contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) which the campaign has received from party committees. (A party committee means any committee that is part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.) Such receipts are reported on Line 18b of Schedule A. (Note that any loans received from party committees are shown in the columns labeled ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS or MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**NET PARTY CONTRIB:**

This column shows the amount of contributions received (and retained) from party committees. The amount is equal to the TOTAL PARTY CONTRIB shown in the previous column, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to party committees, as reported on Line 27a of Schedule B.

**TOTAL NON-PARTY CONTRIB:**

This column shows the sum of all contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) which the campaign has reported receiving from non-party committees. (A non-party committee means any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.) Such receipts are reported on Line 18b of Schedule A. (Note that any loans received from non-party committees are shown in the categories ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS or MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**NET NON-PARTY CONTRIB:**

This column shows the amount of contributions received (and retained) from non-party committees. The amount is equal to the TOTAL NON-PARTY CONTRIB shown in the previous column, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to non-party committees, as reported on Line 27a of Schedule B.

**CONTRIB FROM OTHER COMM:**

This column shows contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) received from all other committees not accounted for in previous columns. Amounts are determined by subtracting, from the total amount of contributions received from all political committees (Line 18c, Column A), the following amounts: transfers between committees within the same 1980 primary campaign, total party contributions, and total non-party contributions. This column may include contributions from political committees authorized by other candidates for Federal

office, contributions from political committees authorized by the same candidate in conjunction with a previous or subsequent candidacy for Federal office, contributions from joint fundraising committees, and contributions from unregistered committees.

**ITEMIZED LOANS FROM CANDIDATE:**

This figure is the amount of itemized loans which a campaign has received from the candidate, as reported on Line 20a of Schedule A.

**ITEMIZED LOANS WITHIN CAMPAIGN:**

This column shows the total amount of itemized loans which the candidate and his/her 1980 primary campaign committees have received from each other. These loans are disclosed on Line 20a of Schedule A.

**ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS:**

This column shows itemized loans received from individuals, from candidates and political committees that are not part of the campaign, from organizations which are not registered under the Federal Election Campaign Act, and from banks in the ordinary course of business. Line 20a of Schedule A is the source.

**ITEMIZED LOAN REPY CAMPAIGN/CANDIDATE (Itemized Loan Repayments within the Campaign or to the Candidate):**

This column shows the total amount of itemized loan repayments which the candidate and his/her 1980 primary campaign committees have received from each other. These transactions are reported on Line 20a of Schedule A.

**ITEMIZED OTHER LOAN REPAYMENTS:**

This amount includes itemized loan repayments received from individuals, from candidate and political committees that are not part of the campaign, and from organizations which are not registered under the Federal Election Campaign Act. The source is Line 20a of Schedule A of the campaign's reports.

**ITEMIZED OTHER LOAN REPAYMENTS:**

This amount includes itemized loan repayments received from individuals, from candidate and political committees that are not part of the campaign, and from organizations which are not registered under the Federal Election Campaign Act. The source is Line 20a of Schedule A of the campaign's report.

**MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS:**

This figure is derived by subtracting the itemized receipts shown in the previous five columns, from the total amount of itemized and unitemized loan and loan repayment receipts, as reported on Line 20c, Column A.

**OTHER INCOME:**

The final column of detailed receipts shows the total amount of other income which has been disclosed on Line 19c, Column A, of the campaign's reports.

**TABLE A2 - CONTRIBUTIONS FROM INDIVIDUALS**

**UNITEMIZED CONTRIB (Unitemized Contributions from Individuals):**

Taken from Line 17b, Column A, of the campaign's reports, this amount represents unitemized individual contributions of monies given directly to the campaign or earmarked through another political committee and unitemized in-kind contributions of services, goods or property. (Checks for individual contributions that banks returned to the campaign because of "non-sufficient funds" have been reported, by some campaigns, as negative receipts and thus netted out of the total

amount of unitemized individual contributions.) (Note that unitemized loans received from individuals are shown in the receipts column MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

The percentage indicates what portion of total individual contributions consisted of unitemized contributions.

**\$1 - \$499 CONTRIB (Itemized \$1 - \$499 Contributions from Individuals):**

This figure is derived by means of subtracting from the total amount of individual contributions reported on Line 17d, Column A, the following: the total amount of unitemized contributions shown in the previous column, the total amount of itemized \$500-and-above contributions from individuals, and the total amount of itemized \$101-and-above contributions from the candidate. (These itemized \$1 - \$499 individual contributions are actually disclosed by the campaign on Line 17a of Schedule A.)

As used in this study, contributions from individuals include monies given directly to the campaign or earmarked through another political committee and in-kind contributions of services, goods or property. (Checks for individual contributions that banks return to the campaign because of "non-sufficient funds" have been reported, by some campaigns, as negative receipts and thus netted out of the total amount of itemized individual contributions.)

Itemized contributions are those which have been identified separately on reports, disclosing the name and address of the contributor, his/her place of business/name of employer and the amount and date of the contribution. Under the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended in 1974 and 1976, contributions from individuals had to be itemized if they exceeded (in the aggregate) \$100 per candidate, per year. Once an

individual donor's contributions to a candidate exceeded this amount, all subsequent contributions to the same candidate had to be itemized. The 1979 Amendments to the Federal Election Campaign Act, which took effect on January 8, 1980, retained the same itemization rules but raised the dollar amount so that now contributions exceeding \$200 must be itemized. (Note that itemized loans received from individuals are shown in the receipts column ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS.)

The percentage indicates what portion of total individual contributions consisted of itemized contributions which fall in this dollar range.

**\$500 - \$749 CONTRIB (Itemized \$500 - \$749 Contributions from Individuals):**

The amount is the sum of itemized contributions of \$500 - \$749 from individuals. The source is Line 17a of Schedule A. The definition of a contribution and the requirements for itemization are given above in \$1 - \$499 CONTRIB, as is the function of the percentage.

**\$750 & UP CONTRIB (Itemized \$750 & Up Contributions from Individuals):**

The amount is the sum of itemized contributions of \$750-and-up from individuals. The source is Line 17a of Schedule A. The definition of a contributions and the requirements for itemization are given above in \$1 - \$499 CONTRIB, as is the function of the percentage.

**TOTAL INDIV CONTRIB:**

This amount, the sum of the previous four columns, represents the total amount of itemized and unitemized individual contributions (from Line 17d, Column A) minus any itemized \$101-and-above contributions from the candidate.

**ITEM. REFUNDS OF CONTRIB:**

This amount helps give an accurate picture of the individual contributions actually received and accepted by the campaign. The figure includes the amount of any itemized refunds of contributions to individuals which the campaign has reported making on Line 27a of Schedule B. In addition, checks for individual contributions that banks returned to the campaign because of "non-sufficient funds" have been reported, by some campaigns, as disbursements for itemized contribution refunds on Line 27a of Schedule B.

**TABLE A3 - CONTRIBUTIONS FROM POLITICAL COMMITTEES**

**NET PARTY CONTRIB:**

This column shows the amount of contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) received (and retained) from party committees. (A party committee means any committee that is part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.)

The amount is equal to the total contributions which the campaign has received from party committees, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to such committees. The total party contributions are disclosed on Line 18b of Schedule A; the refunds of contributions on Line 27a of Schedule B. (Loans received from party committees are shown in the receipts columns ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS or MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**NET CORPORATION CONTRIB:**

This column shows the amount of contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) received (and retained) from non-party political committees that are connected to corporate organizations. (A non-party committee means any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.)

The amount is equal to the total contributions which the campaign has received from corporation-connected committees, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to such committees. Line 18b of Schedule A gives the receipt of the contribution while Line 27a of Schedule B shows the refund. (Loans received from corporate-connected committees are shown in the receipts columns ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS or MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**NET LABOR CONTRIB:**

This column shows the amount of contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) received (and retained) from non-party political committee that are connected to labor organizations. (A non-party committee means any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.)

The amount is equal to the total contributions which the campaign has received from labor-connected committees, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to such committees. The receipt of the total contributions is reported on Line 18b of Schedule A; the refunds of contributions, on Line 27a of Schedule B. (Loans received from labor-connected committees are shown in the receipts columns ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS or MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**NET NON-CONNECT CONTRIB:**

This column shows the amount of contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) received (and retained) from non-party political committees that have not reported a connected organization. (A non-party committee means any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.)

The amount is equal to the total contributions which the campaign has received from non-connected committees, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to

such committees. Total contributions are disclosed on Line 18b of Schedule A of the campaign's reports, while refunds of contributions are reported on Line 27a of Schedule B. (Loans received from non-connected committees are shown in the receipts columns ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS or MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**NET TRADE/MEMBER/HEALTH:**

This column shows the amount of contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) received (and retained) from non-party political committees which have reported a connection with a trade association or a membership organization or which are in the health-related field.

(A non-party committee means any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.)

The amount is equal to the total contributions which the campaign has received from such committees, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to such committees. The receipt of total contributions is reported on Line 18b of Schedule A; the refunds, on Line 27a of Schedule B. (Loans received from trade/member/health committees are shown in the receipts columns ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS or MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**NET CO-OP CONTRIB:**

This column shows the amount of contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) received (and retained) from non-party political committees which have reported a connection with a cooperative. (A non-party committee means any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party

structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.)

The amount is equal to the total contributions which the campaign has received from such committees, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to such committees. Total contributions are disclosed on Line 18b of Schedule A of the campaign's reports, while refunds of contributions are reported on Line 27a of Schedule B. (Loans received from these committees are shown in the receipts columns ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS or MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**NET CORP W/O STOCK CONTRIB:**

This column shows the amount of contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) received (and retained) from non-party political committees which have reported a connection with a corporation without capital stock. (A non-party committee means any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.)

The amount is equal to the total contributions which the campaign has received from such committees, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to such committees. Total contributions are disclosed on Line 18b of Schedule A of the campaign's reports, while refunds of contributions are reported on Line 27a of Schedule B. (Loans received from these committees are shown in the receipts columns ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS or MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAYMENTS.)

**NET NON-PARTY CONTRIB:**

This column, the summation of the preceding six, shows the amount of contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) received (and retained) from non-party political committees. (A non-party committee means

any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.)

The amount is equal to the total contributions which the campaign has received from non-party committees minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to such committees. The receipt of total contributions is shown on Line 18b of Schedule A of the campaign's reports; the refund of the contributions is reported on Line 27a of Schedule B. (Loans received from non-party committees are shown in the receipts columns ITEMIZED OTHER LOANS or MISC. LOANS & LOAN REPAY-

**TABLE A4 - PRIMARY MATCHING FUND ACTIVITY**  
(INFORMATION CURRENT THROUGH OCTOBER 1981)

**NO. SUBMS CERTIFIED:**

This column gives the number of submissions for matching funds made by a campaign which the Commission has certified for payment by the Secretary of the Treasury.

(A submission means the campaign's request for Federal funds to match those contributions (donations of money only) that are eligible for matching payments. A campaign makes such a request by submitting, to the FEC, the eligible contributions it has received. Each submission may contain any number of contributions.)

**NO. OF CONTRIBUTIONS ON SUBMS:**

The sum of the number of individual contributors on submissions (or on combined resubmissions which replace a number of submissions) which the Commission has certified for payment is displayed here and named "number of contributions."

The figure is an approximation of the number of contributions submitted by a campaign. A slight understatement of the number of contributions may result if the following situation occurs. If several contributions from the same individual are listed on a given submission, the individual is counted as one contributor.

The figure is an overstatement of the number of contributors because it counts as two contributors the same individual who appears on two different submissions.

**AVER CONTRIB AMT ON SUBMS:**

For the submissions (or combined resubmissions replacing a number of submissions) certified for payment by the Commission the sum of the amounts requested is divided by the sum of the NO. OF CONTRIBUTIONS ON SUBMS to determine the average contribution amount. (See the previous category for a definition of the NO. OF CONTRIBUTIONS ON SUBMS.)

**TOT AMT REQUESTED ON SUBMS:**

This column shows the total amount of Federal matching funds requested by the campaign on the submissions (or combined resubmissions replacing a number of submissions) that have been actually certified for payment by the Commission. (Dollars have been used to compute this figure but cents have been ignored.)

**TOT AMT CERTIFIED FOR SUBMS:**

This column shows, for certified submissions, the total amount actually certified for payment by the Commission. (Dollars have been used to compute this figure but cents have been ignored.)

**% MATCHED ON SUBMS:**

This column shows the total amount actually certified divided by the total amount requested by the campaign.

**AMT ORIG NOT CERTIFIED ON SUBMS:**

This column shows the amount of contributions (donations of money only) that the FEC has determined to be non-matchable. The figure is equal to the difference between the amount requested and the amount actually certified for matching payment, except where on a final submission only a portion of the matchable value was certified because the maximum entitlement was reached.

**NO. RESUBMS CERTIFIED:**

This column shows the number of resubmissions and combined resubmissions made by a campaign which the Commission has certified for matching funds.

Note that some types of contributions (donations of money only) which were originally submitted and rejected as non-matchable may be resubmitted with additional necessary information on a resubmission.

**TOT AMT CERTIFIED FOR RESUBMS:**

This column shows, for certified resubmissions and combined resubmissions, the total amount actually certified for payment by the Commission. (Dollars have been used to compute this figure but cents have been ignored.)

**TOT AMT CERTIFIED TO DATE:**

This figure shows the total amount (for submissions and resubmissions and combined resubmissions) actually certified for payments. (Dollars have been used to compute this figure but cents have been ignored.)

(Note that this amount may be larger than that shown on p. 1 of this volume under the category FEDERAL MATCHING FUNDS because the amount given here may reflect payments certified by the Commission during 1981. The figure on p. 1 is based on the amount disclosed by the campaign on its monthly Form 3P reports for 1980.)

**% MATCHED ON SUBMS/RESUBMS:**

This column shows what percentage of total funds requested was actually matched with Federal funds. The percentage is calculated by dividing the total amount actually certified for payment (for certified submissions and resubmissions and combined resubmissions) by the total amount requested (on certified submissions or on combined resubmissions.)

**TOT AMT REJECTED TO DATE:**

This column shows the total amount which, to date, the Commission has rejected for matching funds or for which adjustments were made due to previously matched contributions becoming non-payable upon deposit (NSF). (Dollars have been used to compute this figure but cents have been ignored.)

**NO. SUBMS NOT CERTIFIED:**

This figure shows the number of submissions which the Commission received but for which no payment was certified.

**NO. RESUBMS NOT CERTIFIED:**

This column shows the number of resubmissions and combined resubmissions which the Commission received but for which no payment was certified.

**TOT AMT REQUESTED SUBMS & RESUBMS NOT CERTIFIED:**

This figure is the total amount requested by the campaign on the submissions, resubmissions, and combined resubmissions for which the Commission did not certify payment. (Dollars have been used to compute this figure but cents have been ignored.)

**TOTAL AMOUNT REPAID:**

This column indicates the total amount of Federal matching funds that the candidate has returned to the U.S. Treasury. A repayment may occur if the Commission determines, as a result of an audit or other examination, that a repayment of Federal matching funds is necessary. (Dollars have been used to compute this figure but cents have been ignored.)

TABLE A5 - CASH-ON-HAND AND DEBITS

**BEGINNING CASH-ON-HAND:**

The "cash-on-hand" at the beginning of the reporting period from the first report filed by entities within the primary campaign is given in this column. The source is Line 7, Column A.

**LATEST CASH-ON-HAND:**

This column shows the primary campaign's "cash-on-hand" as reported at the close of the most recent reporting period. It is disclosed on Line 10, Column A.

**DEBITS OWED BY CAMPAIGN:**

This column shows the outstanding debts and obligations owed BY the primary campaign. The figure is from Line 13, Column A.

**DEBITS OWED TO CAMPAIGN:**

This column shows the outstanding debts and obligations owed TO the primary campaign. The amount is as reported on Line 12, Column A.

TABLE A6 - DISBURSEMENTS

**TOTAL DISBURSEMENTS:**

This column includes all outgoing monies, goods and services reported on Line 9, Column A, by the candidate and the committees he/she has authorized for the 1980 primary campaign. (It does not include disbursements made by campaign committees authorized by the candidate in connection with a previous or subsequent Federal election.

**NET DISBURSEMENTS:**

This column shows the actual disbursements made by the candidate and all the committees he/she has authorized for the 1980 primary campaign. It is equal to the total disbursements reported by those campaign committees and the candidate, minus any transfers they have made to each other. ("Transfers," reported on Line 26a or 26b of Schedule B, are the movement of money, goods, property or services between the candidate and his/her authorized committees or between those committees.) Note that, if a 1980 primary campaign committee transfers funds to a joint fundraising committee or to a campaign committee that was authorized by the candidate for another Federal campaign, the transaction is regarded as a disbursement to another non-campaign committee, not as an internal transfer. (Note that previous FEC studies used the word "transfer" to mean any contribution made to or by a political committee. Under this study, contributions made to political committees which are not part of the candidate's 1980 primary campaign are called "contributions".)

**ITEMIZED LOAN REPAY. TO CANDIDATE:**

This figure is the amount of itemized loan repayments which the campaign has made to the candidate. Information is from Line 27a of Schedule B.

**ITEMIZED LOAN REPY WITHIN CAMPAIGN:**

This column shows the total amount of itemized loan repayments which the candidate's 1980 authorized primary campaign committees have made to each other. These loan repayments are disclosed on Line 27a of Schedule B.

**ITEMIZED OTHER LOAN REPAYMENTS:**

This column shows itemized loan repayments to individuals, to candidate and political committees which are not part of the campaign, to organizations which are not registered under the Federal Election Campaign Act, and to banks for loans previously made in the ordinary course of business. Line 27a of Schedule B is the source.

**ITEMIZED LOANS TO CAMPAIGN/CANDIDATE (Itemized Loans Made within the Campaign or to the Candidate):**

Shown here is the total amount of itemized loans which the candidate and his/her 1980 primary authorized campaign committees have made to each other. These transactions are reported on Line 27a of Schedule B.

**ITEMIZED LOANS TO OTHERS:**

This column shows itemized loans made to individuals, to candidates and political committees which are not part of the campaign, or to organizations which are not registered under the Federal Election Campaign Act. The source is Line 27a of Schedule B of the campaign's reports.

**MISC. LNS/LN REPY/CONTRIB REFUNDS:**

This column shows miscellaneous loans, loan repayments and refunds of contributions (donations of money, services, goods or property) (Checks for individual contributions that banks returned to the campaign because of "non-sufficient funds" have been reported, by some campaigns, as disbursements for contribution refunds on Line 27b, Column A.) This figure is derived by subtracting the itemized disbursements in the previous five columns from the total amount of itemized and unitemized loans, loan repayments and refunds of contributions, which a campaign has reported on Line 27c, Column A.

**EXEM FUND/LEGAL/ACCT DISBURSE (Disbursements Relating to Exempt Fundraising, Legal and Accounting Fees):**

This column shows the total amount of those fundraising, legal and accounting fees that are exempt from expenditure limits. (See 2 U.S.C. §441a(b) and §431(9)(B)(vi) and(vii).) They are reported on Line 25c, Column A.

**CONTRIB TO OTHER POLITICAL COMM:**

This column shows total contributions (donations of money or in-kind contributions of services, goods or property) made to political committees that are not affiliated with the primary campaign. (Political committee means a committee that has registered under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended, and files campaign finance reports and statements under the Act.) Figures are derived by subtracting the total amount of disbursements for internal transfers within the 1980 primary campaign (see the column NET DISBURSEMENTS for an explanation of internal transfers) from the total amount of contributions the campaign has made to all political committees, as reported on Line 26c, Column A.

**OPERATING EXPEND:**

This column shows the sum of all operating expenditures reported by the campaign on Line 24c, Column A.

**EXPEND. SUBJECT TO LIMIT:**

This column shows expenditures that the campaign has reported as being subject to the limitations of the Act (2 U.S.C. §441a(b)). The figure is equal to the sum of operating expenditures (minus refunds/rebate receipts)

and contributions— donations of money, services, goods or property—the campaign has made to political committees not affiliated with the campaign. (Political committee means a committee that has registered under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended, and files campaign finance reports and statements under the Act.) Information is taken from Line 15a, Column A.

**TABLE A7 - EXPENDITURES, DISBURSEMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS COSTS BY OTHERS**

**INDEP EXPEND FOR CAND:**

The figure here shows independent expenditures advocating the election of a clearly identified candidate registered with the Commission. (Independent expenditures are expenditures for communications which are made expressly to advocate the election of a clearly identified candidate but which are not made with the cooperation of, or in consultation with, the candidate or his/her agents or authorized committees.) Amounts included in this column were spent during the period the candidate was actually a registered candidate.

Information was taken from reports filed by non-party committees on Line 23 of Schedule E of FEC Form 3 (or Line 22 of Schedule E of FEC Form 3X) or by independent expenditure filers on FEC Form 5 filed with the Commission. (A non-party committee means any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.)

**DELEGATE/DELEGATE COMM DISBURSE FOR (Delegate/ Delegate Committee Disbursements for the Campaign):**

Shown here are total disbursements (all outgoing monies, goods and services) of delegate and delegate-committee filers which are financially unauthorized by the campaign but which

have indicated on FEC Form 5a that they advocate the election of only this candidate.

**DRAFT COMM DISBURSEMENTS:**

This column shows total disbursements (all outgoing monies, goods and services) made by draft committees. (Draft committees are unauthorized political committees registered with the Commission which make disbursements exclusively on behalf of a single individual who, at the time the disbursements are made, is not a candidate under the Federal Election Campaign Act.)

(Note that once an individual, previously supported by a draft committee, becomes a candidate the financial activities of the draft committee for reporting periods subsequent to the ones in which the candidacy occurred are treated as those of any other non-campaign committee, i.e., activity might appear under CONTRIBUTIONS FROM OTHER COMMITTEES (TABLE A1) or under INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES FOR CANDIDATE (TABLE A7). The total disbursements reported by a draft committee for the reporting period in which the candidacy occurred are included in this column, except that they are reduced by the amount of any independent expenditures disclosed on the same report which occurred after the actual date of the candidacy, because such expenditures appear under INDEP EXPEND FOR CAND.)

**COMMUNICATIONS COSTS FOR:**

This column shows the total amount of treasury funds spent by corporations, labor unions and other membership organizations to make internal communications which advocate the election of a clearly identified candidate.

These communications may be made only to certain categories of individuals (i.e., by a corporation, to its stockholders or executive and administrative personnel, or by a membership organization (including a union) to its members). The corporation or membership organization is not required to report these costs to the Commission

on FEC Form 7 until they exceed \$2,000 per election. Thereafter, each additional communications cost is also reported.

**INDEP EXPEND AGAINST CAND:**

The figure here shows independent expenditures advocating the defeat of a clearly identified candidate registered with the Commission. (Independent expenditures are expenditures for communications which are made expressly to advocate the defeat of a clearly identified candidate but which are not made with the cooperation of, or in consultation with, the candidate or his/her agents or authorized committees.) Amounts included in this column were spent during the period the candidate was actually a registered candidate.

Information was taken from reports filed by non-party committees on Line 23 of Schedule E of FEC Form 3 (or Line 22 of Schedule E of FEC Form 3X) or by independent expenditure filers on FEC Form 5 filed with the Commission. (A non-party committee means any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.)

**COMMUNICATIONS COSTS AGAINST:**

This column shows the total amount of treasury funds spent by corporations, labor unions and other membership organizations to make internal communications which advocate the defeat of a identified candidate.

These communications may be made only to certain categories of individuals (i.e., by a corporation, to its stockholders or executive and administrative personnel, or by a membership organization (including a union) to its members). The corporation or membership organization is not required to report these

costs to the Commission on FEC Form 7 until they exceed \$2,000 per election. Thereafter, each additional communications cost is also reported.

**TABLE A8 - STATE-BY-STATE EXPENDITURES**

**STATE EXPEND LIMIT:**

This column shows current expenditure limits for each State, the District of Columbia, the Commonwealth of Puerto Rico and U.S. territories or possessions. 2 U.S.C. §441a(b) limits not only the total amount of expenditures which a candidate eligible to receive Federal matching funds may make, but also the amount which may be expended in any one State.

**TOTAL EXP TO DATE:**

This column shows total expenditures made in a State which are subject to the State limitation. Information is from FEC Form 3Pc.

**TABLE B - RECEIPTS: NET RECEIPTS FOR DIFFERENT CAMPAIGNS BY RECEIPT AMOUNT**

**CAMPAIGNS:**

The campaigns are listed alphabetically under their respective parties. The candidate's party is reported on the Statement of Candidate filed with the Commission.

**RECEIPT AMOUNT:**

NET RECEIPTS are the actual receipts of the candidate and all the committees he/she authorized for the 1980 primary campaign. They are equal to the total

receipts reported by those campaign committees and the candidate, minus any transfers they have received from each other.

The number (#) portion of the column shows the number of campaigns which have reported net receipts in the dollar range of the particular column (e.g., under \$1,000,000). For each specified campaign the number is one (1).

The dollar (\$) portion of the column shows the campaign's net receipts. The amount is recorded under the appropriate dollar range. For example, if candidate "X" actually receives \$1.5 million, that amount appears in the column labeled "\$1,000,000 - \$4,999,999."

The percent (%) shows what portion of net receipts reported by all Presidential campaigns fell in a given dollar range.

**TABLE C - DISBURSEMENTS: NET DISBURSEMENTS FOR DIFFERENT CAMPAIGNS BY DISBURSEMENT AMOUNT**

**CAMPAIGNS:**

The campaigns are listed alphabetically under their respective parties. The candidate's party is reported on the Statement of Candidate filed with the Commission.

**DISBURSEMENT AMOUNT:**

**NET DISBURSEMENTS** are the actual disbursements made by the candidate and all the committees he/she has authorized for the 1980 primary campaign. They are equal to the total disbursements reported by those campaign committees and the candidate, minus any transfers they have made to each other.

The number (#) portion of the column shows the number of campaigns which have reported net disbursements in the dollar range of the particular column (e.g., under \$1,000,000). For each specified campaign the number is one (1).

The dollar (\$) portion of the column shows the campaign's net disbursements. The amount is recorded under the appropriate dollar range. For example, if candidate "X" actually disburses \$1.5 million, that amount appears in the column labeled "\$1,000,000 - \$4,999,999."

The percent (%) shows what portion of net disbursements reported by all Presidential campaigns fell in a given dollar range.

**TABLE D - CONTRIBUTIONS FROM INDIVIDUALS: TOTAL INDIVIDUAL CONTRIBUTIONS TO DIFFERENT CAMPAIGNS BY CONTRIBUTION AMOUNT**

**CAMPAIGNS:**

The campaigns are listed alphabetically under their respective parties. The candidate's party is reported on the Statement of Candidate filed with the Commission.

#### CONTRIBUTION AMOUNT:

As used in this study, contributions from individuals include monies given directly to the campaign or earmarked through another political committee and in-kind contributions of services, goods or property. (Checks for individual contributions that banks returned to the campaign because of "non-sufficient funds" have been reported, by some campaigns, as negative receipts and thus netted out of the total amount of individual contributions.)

Itemized contributions are those which have been identified separately on reports, disclosing the name and address of the contributor, his/her place of business/name of employer and the amount and date of the contribution. Under the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended in 1974 and 1976, contributions from individuals had to be itemized if they exceeded (in the aggregate) \$100 per candidate, per year. Once an individual donor's contributions to a candidate exceeded this amount, all subsequent contributions to the same candidate had to be itemized. The 1979 Amendments to the Federal Election Campaign Act, which took effect on January 8, 1980, retained the same itemization rules but raised the dollar amount so that now contributions exceeding \$200 must be itemized. The dollar (\$) portion of the column shows the total amount of the individual contributions that fell into the particular dollar range.

The percent (%) shows what portion of all individual contributions reported by a Presidential primary campaign fell within a given dollar range.

#### TABLE E - CONTRIBUTIONS FROM POLITICAL COMMITTEES: NET NON-PARTY AND PARTY COMMITTEE CONTRIBUTIONS TO DIFFERENT CAMPAIGNS BY POLITICAL COMMITTEE TYPE

#### CAMPAIGNS:

The campaigns are listed alphabetically under their respective parties. The candidate's party is reported on the Statement of Candidate filed with the Commission.

#### POLITICAL COMMITTEE TYPE:

NET CONTRIBUTIONS means the amount of contributions (donations of money, services, goods or property) received and actually retained by a campaign. It is equal to the total contributions reported by the candidate and all the committees he/she has authorized for the 1980 primary campaign, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to contributors. Such refunds of contributions might occur when a candidate decides not to accept contributions from certain types of political committees.

This TABLE categorizes political committees according to their relationship to other organizations. Non-party committees are grouped under the following organization categories: committees connected to corporations; to labor organizations; to trade, membership and health organizations; to cooperatives; and to corporations without stock; committees with no connected organization. **CAMPAIGNS:**

There is a separate page for each of the campaigns. Another page summarizes TABLE F activity for all campaigns included in this volume.

**DATE CONTRIBUTION RECEIVED:**

This row indicates the date on which the campaign received the contribution (or made the refund of a contribution). Because contributions or refunds of contributions with incomplete dates cannot be placed within a specific date range, they are included in the final category labeled "after 7/31/80 and no date."

**POLITICAL COMMITTEE TYPE:**

NET CONTRIBUTIONS means the amount of contributions (donations of money, services, goods or property) received and actually retained by a campaign. It is equal to the total contributions reported by the candidate and all the committees he/she has authorized for the 1980 primary campaign, minus any itemized contributions the campaign has returned to contributors. Such refunds of contributions might occur when a candidate decides not to accept contributions from certain types of political committees.

The TABLE categorizes political committees according to their relationship to other organizations. Non-party committees are grouped under the following organization categories: committees connected to corporations; to labor organizations; to trade, membership and health organizations; to cooperatives; and to corporations without stock; committees with no connected organization. (A non-party committee means any committee that has not been authorized by any candidate and is not part of the official party structure at the national, State or local level, which has registered as a political committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act, as amended.) CAMPAIGNS:

The campaigns each have a separate column. As used in this study, contributions from individuals include monies given directly to the campaign or earmarked through another political committee and in-kind contributions of services, goods or property. (Checks for individual contributions that banks returned to the campaign because of "non-sufficient funds" have been reported, by some campaigns as negative receipts and thus netted out of the total amount of individual contributions.)

Itemized contributions are those which have been identified separately on reports, disclosing the name and address of the contributor, his/her place of business/name of employer and the amount and date of the contribution. Under the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended in 1974 and 1976, contributions from individuals had to be itemized if they exceeded (in the aggregate) \$100 per candidate, per year. Once an individual donor's contributions to a candidate exceeded this amount, all subsequent contributions to the same candidate had to be itemized. The 1979 Amendments to the Federal Election Campaign Act, which took effect on January 8, 1980, retained the same itemization rules but raised the dollar amount so that now contributions exceeding \$200 must be itemized. This TABLE, however, provides information for only itemized contributions of \$500 or more, because of a change in Commission policy concerning data entry into its computer system.

The number (#) portion of the column shows the number of itemized individual contributions campaign has received from a particular State. State identification is based on the contributor's address as reported by the campaign.

The dollar (\$) portion of the column shows the total amount of such itemized individual contributions.

The percent (%) shows what portion of such itemized individual contributions received by a campaign came from a given State.

ADDRESS OF CONTRIBUTOR:

This row shows the State identified in the individual contributor's address. If a contribution from an American citizen with an address in the Canal Zone was reported as having been received before October 1, 1979, it is shown under "Canal Zone". Otherwise it is included in the category "Citizens Abroad," as are all other contributions received from American citizens and permanent resident aliens who reside abroad.

If the State address of a contribution is incomplete, the contribution is placed in the final row, "no state."
