PART I: End-of-Cycle Reporting Requirements

- Filing information for remainder of 2024
 - ◇ **EXAMPLE:** Post-Election Detailed Summary Page
- Using best efforts for timely filing
- Administrative Fine Program
- Requests for Additional Information (RFAIs)
- Categories of review
- Responding to RFAIs
- Referrals to the Audit Division, General Counsel and Alternative Dispute Resolution Offices

PART II: Process for Ongoing and Terminating Committees

- Keeping the campaign committee open
 - ◇ Use existing committee for election next cycle
 - ◇ Create new committee
 - ◇ Convert to nonconnected PAC
- Terminating the campaign committee
 - ◇ Eligibility to terminate
 - ◇ Termination report
 - ◇ Administrative termination

PART III: Use of Campaign Funds

- Permissible use of campaign funds
- Prohibited personal use
- The irrespective test

PART IV: How to Handle Debts and Loans

- Candidate loan reporting
 - ◇ **EXAMPLE:** Repayment of Candidate Personal Funds Loan
 - ◇ **EXAMPLE:** Candidate Loan Forgiveness
- Disclosing debts
 - ◇ **EXAMPLE:** Calculating Net Debts Outstanding
- Retiring debts by sale of committee assets
- Disputed and unenforceable debts
- Debt settlement (including Debt Settlement Plan (FEC Form 8))
