Mr. Berkon,

On December 14, 2023, the Federal Election Commission considered your Request for Consideration of a Legal Question for Stop These Oppressive People: Tyrants Racists Unqualifieds Misogynists Propagandists ("STOP TRUMP") ("Committee"). The Commission was unable to resolve the question presented or provide guidance to the Reports Analysis Division ("RAD") on how to proceed with the matter by the affirmative vote of four or more Commissioners. See Policy Statement Regarding a Program for Requesting Consideration of Legal Questions by the Commission, 84 Fed. Reg. 36602 (July 29, 2019). Therefore, RAD may proceed with the Office of General Counsel's ("OGC") conclusion, and consistent its own prior determination, that the Committee's name on its Statement of Organization includes the name of a federal candidate as proscribed by 52 U.S.C. § 30102(e)(4). *Id.* at 36603. I have attached a copy of the Commission's vote certification and OGC's recommendation memorandum to the Commission.
