3. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

Approve Findings 1, 2, 3, 4 and 6, as recommended in the Memorandum from the Chief Compliance Officer and the Audit Division dated February 10, 2022.

Commissioners Broussard, Cooksey, Dickerson, Trainor, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the decision.

4. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

Reject Finding 5 in accordance with the summary judgement order handed down by the Court of the District of Columbia in *Cruz v. Federal Election Commission*.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub dissented.

5. Failed by a vote of 3-3 to:

Approve Finding 5 only to the extent it encompasses the individual contributions that would be potentially excessive and not affected by the existence or non-existence of the regulation at issue in the Cruz litigation.

Commissioners Broussard, Walther, and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, and Trainor dissented.
