

Upon consideration of the Motion to Direct Federal Election Commission to Certify the Administrative Record filed by plaintiffs Campaign Legal Center and Ms. Catherine Hinckley Kelley, it is hereby ORDERED that the Federal Election Commission file a certified list of the contents of the administrative record of Matter Under Review 7146 (Correct the Record) with this Court, and produce the certified contents of the administrative record, in electronic format, to plaintiffs and defendant-intervenors Correct the Record and Hillary for America within 45 days of the date of this order.

It is further ORDERED that defendant-intervenors' proposed motion to dismiss be deemed filed on the date the Federal Election Commission satisfies the terms of this order by filing a certified list of the contents of the administrative record and producing the record to the parties. Defendant-intervenors shall have 30 days from the date the Federal Election Commission satisfies the terms of this order to amend their motion to dismiss, if they so choose, and plaintiffs shall have 30 days from the date the proposed motion to dismiss is deemed filed *or* intervenors file an amended motion to dismiss, whichever is later, to file their response.
