SCHEDULING ORDER

In consideration of the parties' statements concerning the schedule in this case, it is hereby ORDERED that the following schedule is established:

1. The Federal Election Commission ("FEC"), after entry of a mutually agreeable protective order, shall file under seal a chronology regarding the remanded Americans for Job Security matter by July 21, 2017.
2. Defendant FEC and Intervenor-Defendant American Action Network ("AAN") shall file separate motions and briefs.
3. The FEC's Motion for Summary Judgment and Memorandum of Points and Authorities shall be filed by July 21, 2017. The FEC's Memorandum of Points and Authorities shall not exceed 45 pages.
4. AAN's Motion for Summary Judgment and Memorandum of Points and Authorities shall be filed by July 21, 2017. AAN's Memorandum of Points and Authorities shall not exceed 35 pages.

5. Plaintiffs' Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment, together with a combined Memorandum of Points and Authorities supporting the Plaintiffs' Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment and opposing the FEC's and AAN's Motions for Summary Judgment, shall be filed by September 12, 2017. Plaintiffs' combined Memorandum of Points and Authorities shall not exceed 50 pages.
6. The FEC's combined Reply in support of its Motion for Summary Judgment and Opposition to the Plaintiffs' Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment shall be filed by October 27, 2017, and shall not exceed 50 pages.
7. AAN's combined Reply in support of its Motion for Summary Judgment and Opposition to the Plaintiffs' Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment shall be filed by October 27, 2017, and shall not exceed 40 pages.
8. Plaintiffs' Reply in support of their Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment shall be filed by December 1, 2017, and shall not exceed 45 pages.
9. Pursuant to Local Civil Rule 7(n)(2), Plaintiffs shall file by December 29, 2017, a joint appendix containing copies of those portions of the administrative record that are cited or otherwise relied upon in any memorandum filed by the parties.
