DEFENDANT FEDERAL ELECTION COMMISSION’S MOTION TO DISMISS

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6), defendant Federal Election Commission (“Commission” or “FEC”) moves to dismiss the Complaint filed by plaintiffs Free Speech for People and Campaign for Accountability (Compl. (Doc. 1).) Plaintiffs bring this action against the FEC for declaratory and injunctive relief pursuant to the Federal Election Campaign Act’s (“FECA”) judicial review provision, 52 U.S.C. § 30109(a)(8)(A). However, plaintiffs’ Complaint fails to state a claim on which relief can be granted because the agency action they challenge is not subject to judicial review. Accordingly, this action should be dismissed with prejudice. A supporting memorandum of points and authorities and a proposed order accompany this motion.
