O R D E R

On September 5, 2024, we answered the district court's certified question in this case in the negative. *Nat'l Republican Senatorial Comm. v. Fed. Election Comm'n*, 117 F.4th 389 (6th Cir. 2024). The Supreme Court then granted a petition for a writ of certiorari, reversed our judgment, and remanded for further proceedings consistent with its opinion. *Nat'l Republican Senatorial Comm. v. Fed. Election Comm'n*, 609 U.S. ____ (June 30, 2026).

In light of the foregoing, we **REMAND** the case to the district court for further proceedings.
