Report of the Audit Division on Steve Israel for Congress Committee

January 1, 2005 - December 31, 2006

Why the Audit Was Done

Federal law permits the Commission to conduct audits and field investigations of any political committee that is required to file reports under the Federal Election Campaign Act (the Act). The Commission generally conducts such audits when a committee appears not to have met the threshold requirements for substantial compliance with the Act. The audit determines whether the committee complied with the limitations, prohibitions and disclosure requirements of the Act.

Future Action

The Commission may initiate an enforcement action, at a later time, with respect to any of the matters discussed in this report.

Steve Israel for Congress Committee is the principal campaign committee for Steve Israel, Democratic candidate for the U.S. House of Representatives from the state of New York, 2nd District, and is headquartered in Dix Hills, New York. 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Part I Background

Authority for Audit

This report is based on an audit of Steve Israel for Congress Committee, undertaken by the Audit Division of the Federal Election Commission (the Commission) in accordance with the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the Act). The Audit Division conducted the audit pursuant to 2 U.S.C. §438(b), which permits the Commission to conduct audits and field investigations of any political committee that is required to file a report under 2 U.S.C. §434. Prior to conducting any audit under this subsection, the Commission must perform an internal review of reports filed by selected committees to determine if the reports filed by a particular committee meet the threshold requirements for substantial compliance with the Act. 2 U.S.C. §438(b).

Scope of Audit

Following Commission-approved procedures, the Audit staff evaluated various risk factors and as a result, the scope of this audit was limited to the following:

- 1. The consistency between reported figures and bank records;
- 2. The disclosure of individual contributors' occupation and name of employer; and
- 3. The receipt and permissibility of loans.
