Thank you for your patience in my reply to the DFAR and audit findings.

Reporting of Apparent Expenditures

The items in question were for fundraising purposes and not electioneering and did not require being reported as Independent expenditure.

Regarding items not timely filed. It is our goal to comply and timely file. We have tightened procedures to insure that future items are timely filed and have discussed with the committees consultants how we can improve the communication of their work to myself the treasurer.

Recordkeeping for Communications

We have made improvements to our recordkeeping procedures for items.

I have included copies of invoices from Frontline Strategies and Media that show their invoices totaling \$172,492.72. These were for fundraising commission and not communications.
