Upon consideration of the Plaintiff's Motion for Expedited Consideration and To Shorten Time, the defendant's opposition, the parties' arguments at the Status Conference held this date, and the entire record in this matter, it is hereby

ORDERED that the FEC shall file its answer, its opposition to the plaintiff's summary judgment motion and its supporting chronology on or before October 3, 1996; it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the plaintiff shall file its reply, if any, not later than October 10, 1996; it is

FURTHER ORDERED that all papers are to be served by hand delivery to the opposing side on the date that such papers are filed with the Court; it is

FURTHER ORDERED that should the parties propose that portions of their filings be placed under seal, they shall identify those portions on a line-by-line, word-by-

word basis and identify with particularity in an accompanying motion to seal with associated memorandum of law why such lines or words must be placed under seal. As the Court stated in open Court, sealing is disfavored and should be requested sparingly. However, if the parties move to seal portions of their filings, redacted copies of those filings for the public docket shall also be filed; and it is

FURTHER ORDERED that the plaintiff shall file its unredacted complaint under seal. After consideration of the pending motion for summary judgment, the Court will review whether the sealing of this complaint and other sealed filings, if any, as well as the sealed of filings in the related case, Civ. No. 95-349, should be lifted. IT IS SO ORDERED.
