Notice is given that all Plaintiffs (Republican Party of Louisiana, Jefferson Parish Republican Parish Executive Committee, and Orleans Parish Republican Executive Committee) hereby appeal to the United States Supreme Court from this Court's Memorandum Opinion (Doc. 66, filed November 7, 2016) and Order (Doc. 67, filed November 7, 2016), denying Plaintiffs' Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. 33) and granting Defendant Federal Election Commission's Motion for Summary Judgment (Doc. 41). Direct appeal is taken pursuant to § 403(a)(3) of the Bipartisan Campaign Reform Act of 2002, Pub. L. No. 107-155, 116 Stat. 81, 113-14, which provides for appeal to the U.S. Supreme Court from such "final decision(s)."
