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## MATCHING FUND CERTIFICATIONS FOR PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES

WASHINGTON - MARCH 4 - The Federal Election Commission today certified \$352,351.45 in federal primary matching funds for 2 Presidential candidates.

The candidates, and amounts certified today, are as follows:

President Gerald R. Ford.....\$284,389.68  
Senator Henry M. Jackson.....\$ 67,961.77

This raises to \$10,544,278.20 the amount of primary matching funds certified this year by the FEC for 14 candidates.

Total matching funds including today's certifications, broken down by candidates are as follows:

Only "gifts of money" to a candidate up to \$250 per individual, are eligible for federal matching payments. Under Commission procedures, after a candidate has established "eligibility" for matching funds, the Commission will receive matching requests from the candidate on a weekly basis, and will certify eligible contributions within fifteen days after their submission.

Currently under review by the Commission are another \$520,928.64 matching fund requests from 8 candidates. (Bayh, Carter, Ford, Harris, McCormack, Reagan, Shapp, and Shriver.).

In addition, the Commission to date has certified \$1,610,000.00 in Nominating Convention payments, including \$860,000.00 to the Democratic National Committee and \$750,000.00 to the Republican National Committee.
