## FEC SURVEY LISTS PRESIDENTIAL CANDIDATES ON GENERAL ELECTION BALLOTS

WASHINGTON - OCTOBER 25 - The Federal Election Commission today released a survey of each state, and the District of Columbia, indicating that 15 candidates are on the November 2 general election ballots as candidates for President in various states.

The survey is current through information available on Friday, October 22.

The survey was compiled by the FEC's National Clearinghouse on Election Administration, and is based on information provided by each State and the District of Columbia.
