## FEC RELEASES SUMMARIES OF NON-PARTY POLITICAL COMMITTEE 1977-78 FINANCIAL ACTIVITY

WASHINGTON - November 2, 1978 - The Federal Election Commission today released the latest figures on 1977-78 financial activity of 1828 non-party and non-candidate political committees.

The figures, covering a 21-month period from January 1, 1977 through September 30, 1978, show that the 1828 committees raised \$67.8 million, and spent \$60.4 million, including \$18.7 million spent as contributions to federal candidates. As of September 30, 1978, the committees had \$19.2 million in cash-on-hand, not including a reported \$.9 million in debts owed by the committees or \$1.2 million in debts owed to the committees.

The FEC noted that the study was run on the FEC computer on October 27, 1978, and that data from committees filing their October 10, 1978, quarterly report late may not be complete as of September 30. The gross data for committees which filed October monthly reports (covering through September 30) is included in these figures but the itemized data is not.

Contributions to federal candidates were summarized in the FEC computer study as follows:

- # of Contributors: 1101 committees (60 % of the 1828 non-party and non-candidate committees registered with the FEC during the 1977-78 coverage period) made contributions to federal candidates.
- Type of Candidate: House candidates received \$13.7 million (73%); Senate candidates received \$5.0 million (27%); and Presidential candidates received \$43,000 (.2%).
- By party affiliation: Democratic candidates received \$11.8 million (63%); Republican candidates received \$7.0 million (37%) and minor party and independent candidates received \$11,000 (.06%).
- By candidate status: Incumbents received \$12.5 million (67%); challengers to incumbents received \$3.1 million (16%); and candidates in open-seats (no incumbent running) received \$3.2 million (17%).

The FEC noted the following about the figures:

- receipt and disbursement figures are "adjusted" to subtract out transfers of funds between affiliated committees.
- contribution figures may include contributions for elections other than 1978 elections, such as 1977 special elections or prior-year election debt retirement.
- disbursements in addition to contributions to federal candidates may include any of the following items not broken down in the FEC figures: fund-raising costs; salary, administrative, and operating costs of the committees; contributions to party committees or state/local elections; or other miscellaneous activities reported but not related to federal elections.

Figures in the latest FEC release supercede figures contained in three earlier versions of the FEC financial study, released on March, April and September 1978.
