FEC RELEASES NEW INTERIM SUMMARIES OF NON-PARTY  
POLITICAL COMMITTEE 1977-78 FINANCIAL ACTIVITY

WASHINGTON - January 24, 1979 - The Federal Election Commission today released the latest figures on the 1977-78 financial activities of non-party related/non-candidate political committees.

**SPECIAL NOTE:** As in previous releases, the FEC notes that the figures contained in this latest release are NOT FINAL, but are subject to change after all 1977-78 related reports and amendments have been received and computerized. BEFORE USING THE FIGURES LISTED BELOW, ALL PERSONS SHOULD READ PAGE 2 OF THIS RELEASE FOR THOROUGH EXPLANATION OF WHAT THESE FIGURES REPRESENT. The figures in the summary page of this release are only INTERIM totals of amounts received, contributed to candidates, and otherwise expended during the 1977-78 election cycle.

During the 23-month period (from January 1, 1977, through November 27, 1978, non-party political committees raised \$77.3 million and spent \$75.6 million. For the period January 1, 1977, through October 23, 1978, the committees made \$32.0 million in contributions to federal candidates, and \$241,000 in expenditures on behalf of federal candidates.

The number of non-party political committees involved in this release numbers 1910. However, approximately 200 of the number have ceased operations and are not active at this time. An additional 100 have recently registered, and had little or no activity during the 1978 elections.

The interim computer study was run on January 19, 1979, and included gross receipt and disbursement information, as well as debt status and latest cash-on-hand figures for all reports filed as of that date. Gross information is therefore complete through the 30-day post-General election period (November 27, 1978). Itemized information (such as contributions to candidates and transfers between affiliated committees) is complete through the 10-day pre-General election period (October 23, 1978).

A summary of the latest figures filed with the FEC indicates:

- 1360 non-party political committees contributed \$32 million to federal candidates.
- House candidates received \$23.0 million (72%)  
Senate candidates received \$8.9 million (28%)  
Presidential candidates received \$49,000 (.002%)
- Incumbents received \$19.0 million (59.6%)  
Challengers received \$6.7 million (20.9%)  
Open seat candidates (no incumbent running) received \$6.2 million (19.0%)
- Democratic candidates received \$18.2 million (56.8%)  
Republican candidates received \$13.8 million (43.0%)  
Minor party and independent candidates received \$48,000 (.2%)

Attached to this release is a list of the top 10 political committees in 4 categories (gross receipts minus transfers from affiliated committees, gross disbursements minus transfers to affiliated committees, total contributions to candidates by dollar amount, and latest cash-on-hand.) Also included is a list of the top 10 corporate committees, labor committees, non-connected organizations, trade/membership/health, cooperatives, and corporations without stock committees within each of the 4 categories.

Figures in this latest FEC release supercede figures contained in four earlier interim releases of March, April, September and November 1978.

GUIDELINES FOR USE OF FEC INTERIM RELEASE ON NON-PARTY POLITICAL COMMITTEES

WHAT IS INCLUDED?

- \*\* GROSS receipt and disbursement information for ALL REPORTS RECEIVED BY JANUARY 19, 1979 for the period ending November 27, 1978 (30-day post-General election reports).

(This means that all 30-day post General election figures have been computerized. In addition, 25% of the committees have also filed Year-end reports, meaning that some gross information is complete through December 31, 1978.)

- \*\* ITEMIZED information for all original 10-day pre-General election reports RECEIVED BY JANUARY 19, 1979 for the period ending October 23, 1978 .

This means that:

- 1) total contributions to federal candidates is a INCOMPLETE;
- 2) NO contributions to federal candidates are included if made AFTER October 23, 1978;
- 3) "Adjusted receipts/expenditures" are NEITHER TRUE GROSS NOR NET figures, since transfers between affiliated committees MADE AFTER October 23, 1978, ARE NOT INCLUDED. Therefore, adjusted receipts/expenditures are SUBJECT TO FURTHER CHANGE TO REFLECT TRANSFERS. THEY SHOULD BE REGARDED AS INTERIM TOTALS.

- \*\* All figures may include activity with regard to:

- 1) 1978 General election
- 2) 1978 Primary elections
- 3) 1977 Special elections
- 4) 1976 (or pre-1976) debt retirement

REMINDER:

Contributions made to candidates AFTER OCTOBER 23, 1978 ARE NOT INCLUDED.

Transfers between affiliated committees MADE AFTER OCTOBER 23, 1978 ARE NOT INCLUDED.

Figures are SUBJECT TO CHANGE after Year-end reports and amendments are filed.

Overall spending figures include fundraising and administrative costs IN ADDITION TO contributions to candidates.
