## FEC PUBLISHES 1ST QUARTER NON-FILERS

WASHINGTON -- The Federal Election Commission published today a list of committees authorized by 1980 House and Senate candidates which failed to file the required first quarter financial disclosure report.

The report was due April 15, covering the activity from January 1, 1980, through March 31, 1980. Committees were notified of their filing requirements in advance of the due date and those which failed to file were again notified April 22.

The new Amendments to the Federal Election Campaign Act specify that the Commission publish ONLY those committees authorized by candidates to raise and spend money on their behalf. Therefore, this list does NOT include other types of political committees which may have been required to file.

Any further action by the Commission with regard to non-filing of required disclosure reports will be decided on a case-by-case basis. Based on 1979 Amendments to the law, the Commission is required to provide advance notice to committees of their filing obligations, and to publish the names of those which fail to respond to such notice, if they are operating on a candidate's behalf.
