## PAC'S RAISE OVER \$138 MILLION IN 18 MONTHS — EXCEEDING '80 EFFORTS

WASHINGTON — PAC's raised \$138.4 million and spent \$105.3 million during the first 18 months of the 1981-82 election cycle according to reports filed with the Federal Election Commission.

The FEC released computer indexes this week which summarize the financial activity of each PAC registered with the agency. One index lists all PAC's alphabetically; the other, in descending order of financial activity. Both include all receipts and disbursements made by non-party political committees ("PAC's") from January 1, 1981, through June 30, 1982.\* The alphabetical listing also shows the latest cash-on-hand reported.

Comparable figures on PAC activity for the same time period in the 1979-80 election cycle showed PAC's had raised \$86.1 million and spent \$62.8 million. Their contributions to federal candidates through that date were \$25 million.

In June 1982, the FEC released data which showed PAC contributions to all federal candidates totalling \$22.8 million for 1981 and the first 3 months of 1982. Contributions made during the second quarter of 1982 will be reflected in figures to be released in the fall.

Shown below are the summary figures for each PAC category.

The PAC's with the greatest amount of financial activity are also attached.
