1984 CONGRESSIONAL CAMPAIGNS SET RECORD SPENDING MARK

WASHINGTON — Spending in 1984 Congressional campaigns has risen 21% over 1982 levels according to a new 18-month study released today by the Federal Election Commission.

From January 1, 1983, through June 30, 1984, 2019 candidates for the U.S. Senate and House spent a record \$161.8 million. During that same time period in 1981-82, 2020 candidates spent \$133.6 million. (Reports detailing what Congressional campaigns spent in the third quarter of this year were due earlier this week.)

Fundraising has increased by the same 21 percent - from \$175.6 million at the end of June 1982, to \$213.4 million at the end of the second quarter 1984.

PAC contributions to 1984 Congressional campaigns have increased 46% - to \$50.7 million from \$34.6 million for the same 18-month period in 1981-82. This represents a 143% increase in PAC contributions to U.S. Senate and House campaigns since the last Presidential election cycle in 1979-80.

Contributions from PAC's equaled 23% of all money raised by Congressional candidates in the first 18 months of the 1983-84 election cycle - 16% of the monies raised by Senate candidates and 30% of the funds raised by House campaigns. In 1981-82, PAC money accumulated during the same 18-month period accounted for 19% of campaign receipts - 12% of Senate funds raised and 24% of House receipts. PAC contributions measured as a part of total receipts have therefore increased 4%. The proportion of receipts represented by PAC contributions has increased 21%.

Listed below are comparable 18-month figures for total receipts, expenditures and PAC contributions for 4 election cycles.

The FEC Report shows that both Senate and House candidates have contributed only \$4 million, or 2%, of the total funds raised by their own campaigns. Loans from candidates total \$21.8 million (10%) - \$12.5 million (12.2%) for Senate campaigns, and \$9.2 million (8.3%) for House campaigns.

Political party contributions make up less than 2% of all funds raised.

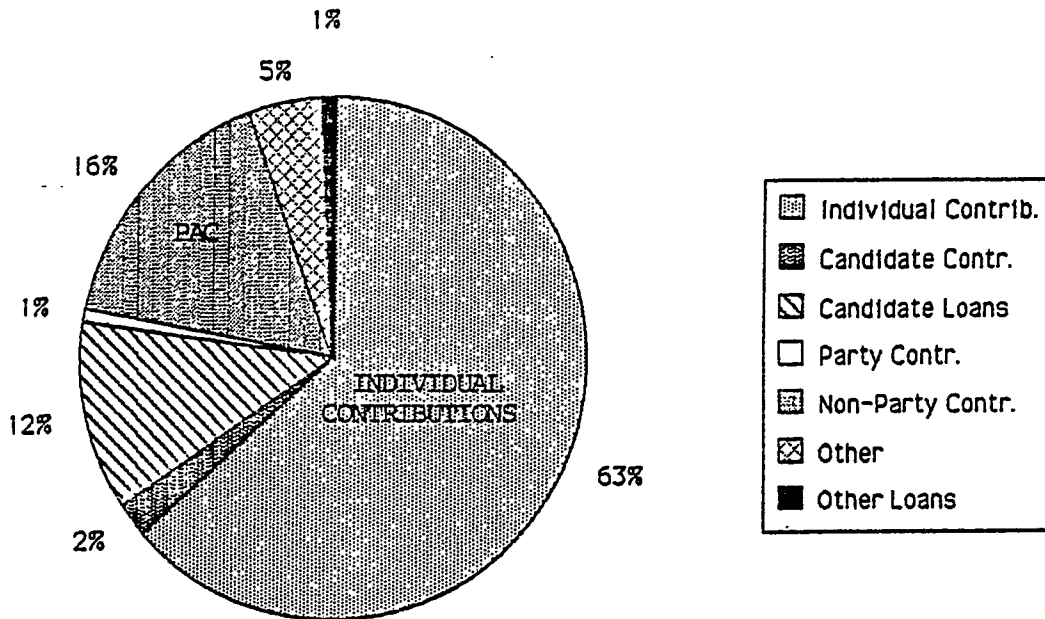

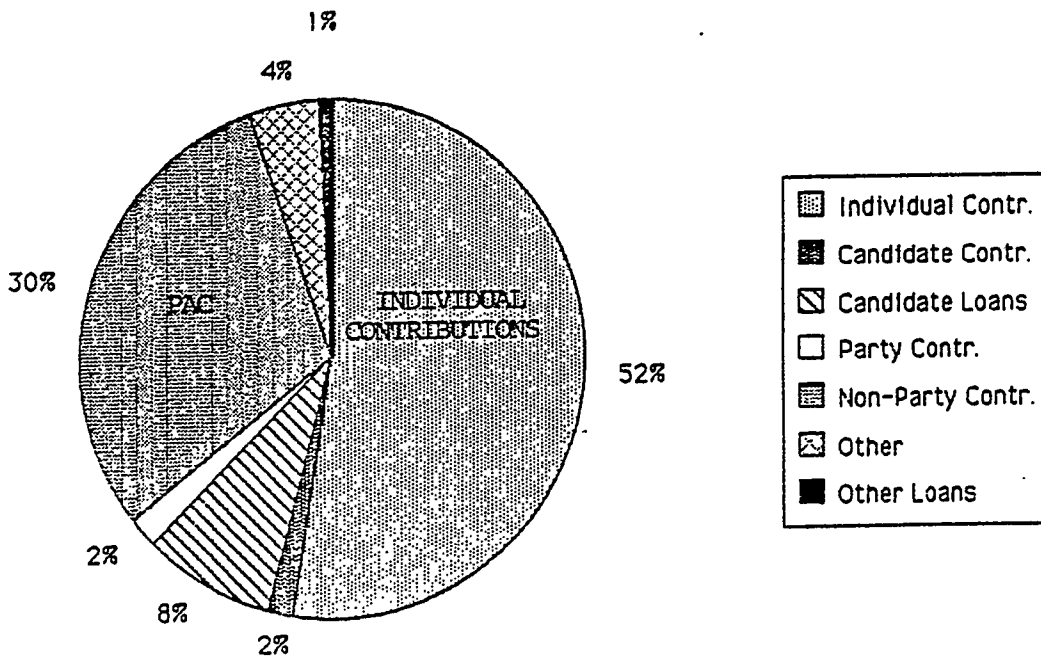

- 1/ Total receipt and disbursement figures are inflated because they double amounts transferred between all committees within a campaign.
- 2/ Variations in reporting patterns regarding candidate contributions and candidate loan activity require caution in interpreting this data. Specifically, the total of candidate contributions and candidate loans may be inflated because loans which have been forgiven may appear in both columns. Any attempt to determine the total amount of financial support by candidates for their own campaigns should include a detailed examination of all reports filed by the campaigns in question.
- 3/ Information on Major Party and PAC contributions is taken from those committees' reports. Total receipts are taken from candidates' campaign reports. Because of the time lag in reporting, Party and PAC contribution categories may include contributions not yet reported by the candidates. Therefore, contributions from committees, as a proportion of total campaign receipts, are slightly overstated in this Report. The aggregate discrepancy is estimated to be approximately 1.5% of total non-party committee contributions, but may be larger in any given campaign.
- 4/ Latest cash-on-hand figures are as of June 30, 1984, or the last report filed by the candidate's campaign.
- 5/ Major party expenditures are monies spent by the National and State party committees of the two major parties on behalf of candidates in the general election ONLY. There are limits on what the parties may spend. These expenditures are in addition to direct contributions.
- 6/ Open Seat Races are those in which the incumbent did not seek re-election.
