FEC RELEASES 18-MONTH PAC STUDY

WASHINGTON — Political action committees contributed \$57 million to federal candidates during the first 18 months of the 1983-84 election cycle, according to an interim study released today by the Federal Election Commission. This represents a 50% increase over PAC contributions of \$38 million given to federal candidates during the same time frame in the 1981-82 cycle, and a 128% increase over the \$25 million contributed in the first 18 months of 1979-80, the last Presidential election cycle.

PAC monies contributed to only 1984 Congressional races for this period totalled \$50.7 million, an increase of 46% over the \$34.6 million contributed to 1982 Congressional candidates, and a 144% increase over the \$20.8 million given to 1980 Senate and House candidates (18 month figures.)

The difference between contributions to all federal candidates and those given to candidates involved in any given election cycle includes contributions to retire debts from previous campaigns and those given for future races.

PAC's began the cycle with \$31.3 million cash-on-hand. They raised \$195.5 million and spent a total of \$148.3 million. As of June 30, 1984, they had \$78.8 million cash-on-hand to begin the third quarter. (See below for comparable figures in past elections.)

In addition to contributions, PAC's have made independent expenditures totalling \$7 million from January 1, 1983, through June 30, 1984. For the same time period in 1981-82, PAC independent expenditures totalled \$3.1 million; in 1979-80, they totalled \$2.8 million. It is inappropriate to compare totals spent in this area in a Presidential election cycle ('80 or '84) with what was spent in a Congressional election cycle ('82), since much of what is spent in a Presidential election year pertains solely to the Presidential election. Also, the circumstances of each Presidential election differ and independent spending may increase significantly as the general election approaches. Therefore, comparison between 1980 and 1984 would be premature at this time.

The FEC Report on Financial Activity, 1983-84 Interim Report No. 8: Party and Non-Party Political Committees covers all financial activity occurring between January 1, 1983, and June 30, 1984. For the first time, the FEC has provided a comparison of PAC activity over four election cycles adjusted for inflation. Listed below are actual figures for 18 months in 1977-78, 1979-80, 1981-82, and 1983-84, followed by figures which have been adjusted to reflect current activity in 1978 dollars.

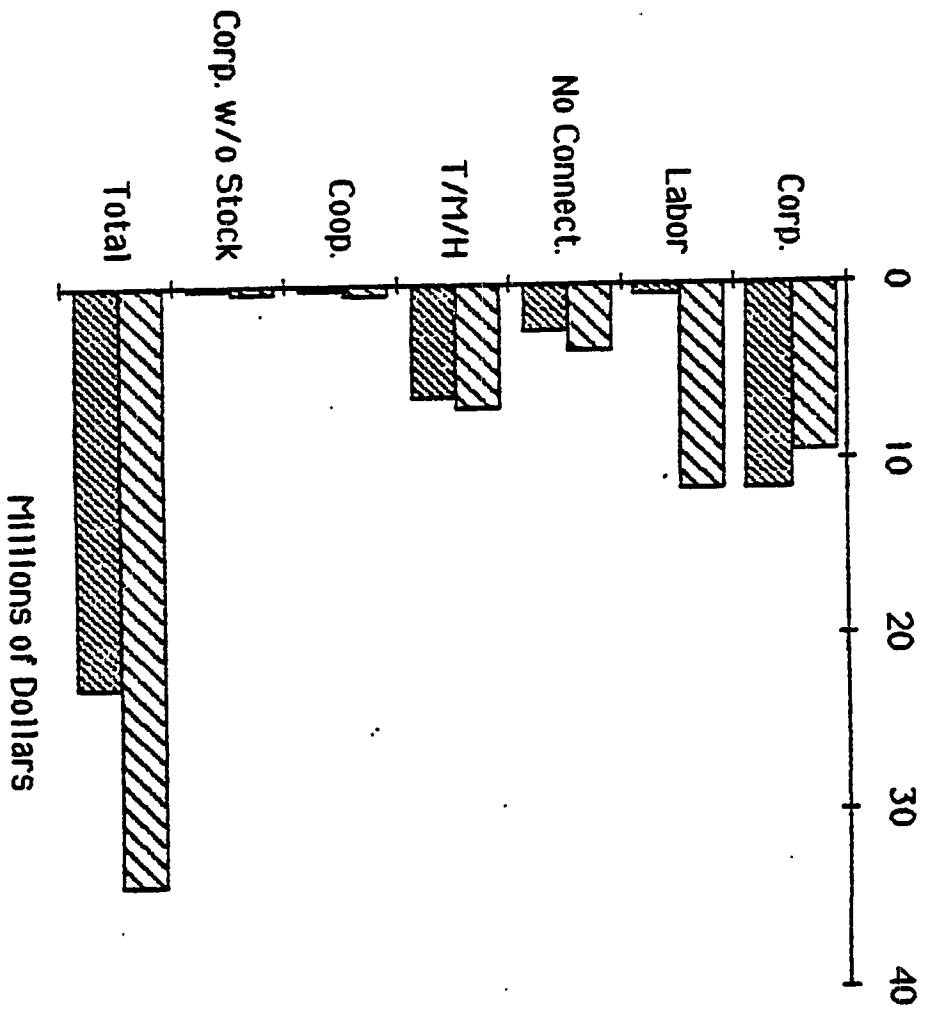
