## FEC RELEASES 15-MONTH FINANCIAL DATA FOR '86 ELECTIONS

WASHINGTON -- With Congressional primaries just underway, spending for 1986 Senate and House races has already topped the \$100 million mark, according to fifteen-month figures released today by the Federal Election Commission.

FEC figures show that Senate candidates have raised almost \$80 million, of which, approximately 68%, or \$54 million was comprised of contributions from individuals; PAC's contributed 21% - more than \$16 million. Spending in Senate races has reached \$46 million.

Candidates for U.S. House seats have raised more than \$87 million: 54%, or \$47 million from individuals, and 30%, or \$26 million from PAC's. Spending has exceeded \$58 million.

The FEC figures were produced via a new program which takes information from the summary pages of reports filed by the Congressional campaigns. Previously, the FEC waited to produce reports based on the details provided by PAC filings. The agency's new program allows summary figures to be compiled in a more rapid fashion and offers comparison figures for incumbents, challengers and open-seat races. (Open seats are those in which the incumbent is not seeking re-election.)

Summary figures provide a basis for analyzing early financial activity. Tables also show that the amount of early PAC money, while increasing, has not increased as dramatically as in past election cycles. Much of the increase thus far has been directed toward Senate campaigns, where several competitive races are anticipated.

Following the tables are lists of the top 50 Senate and House campaigns.

Only candidates who have registered with the FEC for 1986 races are included in the summary. Therefore, since some candidates have yet to register and report, and since other first quarter 1986 reports may have been filed late, the figures may not be totally inclusive of all financial activity for the 1986 elections. Furthermore, while the summary generally covers activity from January 1, 1985, through March 31, 1986, some campaigns have already filed pre-primary reports covering activity beyond the first quarter of 1986.
