FEC SCHEDULES HEARING ON PROPOSED REVISIONS TO REGULATIONS

WASHINGTON--Proposed revisions to Federal Election Commission regulations governing affiliated committees, prohibited contributions, annual contribution limitations and earmarked contributions will be the subject of a public hearing on Wednesday, September 17. Sections of the regulations involved in the proposed rulemaking are 110.3, 4, 5 and 6.

The hearing will begin at 10:00 a.m. in the agency's ninth floor conference room, 999 E Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.

Requests to address the Commission have been received from E. Mark Braden, Chief Counsel, Republican National Committee; Laurence Gold, General Counsel, AFL-CIO; Fred Wertheimer, President, Common Cause. Each participant will be allotted 30 minutes.

The FEC also has available for public inspection written comments submitted by those testifying at the hearing and other interested groups.

Information on the proposed amendments was published in the Federal Register on Wednesday, July 30, 1986.
