CITIZEN INVOLVEMENT: FOCUS OF NEW FEC PUBLICATION

WASHINGTON -- Individuals interested in supporting candidates for Federal office now have a comprehensive guide they can turn to. The Federal Election Commission's new brochure, Supporting Federal Candidates: A Guide for Citizens, describes ways in which people may participate in campaigns for President, House and Senate.

The publication, complete with pictures and clear text, encourages citizen involvement in the electoral process. Information on contributions, volunteer services and independent expenditures is included in the brochure. It also describes how to make use of FEC campaign data and how to file a complaint. Through these campaign activities, citizens can become more involved in the election process.
