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FEC PROVIDES FINANCIAL DATA ON 1988 CONGRESSIONAL CANDIDATES

WASHINGTON — With the first 1988 Congressional primaries just weeks away, the Federal Election Commission has prepared a summary of financial activity through December 31, 1987, for Senate and House candidates. During the last calendar year, Congressional candidates raised more than \$118.6 million and spent nearly \$66.2 million. The report, which looks at 65 Senate candidates and 584 House candidates, also provides an overview of money raised and spent by Senate incumbents, dating back to their last election in 1982.

A summary table breaks out the data for Senate and House candidates by party as well as by candidate status (incumbent/challenger/open seat), and includes the financial activity from four special elections. Following that chart are lists showing the 50 top money raisers and spenders, for both the Senate and House, as well as those candidates who have received the most funds from individuals and political committees, and those with the most cash-on-hand and outstanding debts. Note that candidates involved in special elections may show greater amounts of financial activity in 1987 than other candidates. Also, some candidates have changed plans since the first of this year: retiring, running for a different office, or reconsidering an earlier decision. As a result, the classification of candidates may change as time goes on.

On subsequent pages, individual Senate candidates are listed with total receipts and disbursements for each two-year cycle during which they reported financial activity. Transfers of funds between committees of the same campaign have been subtracted. Contributions from individuals and PAC's are listed for each cycle.* The cash-on-hand and debts owed by each campaign are provided for the end of each two-year cycle from December 31, 1982, through December 31, 1987. Some of the financial activity reported during the six-year period may relate to a prior election and should not automatically be presumed to be part of the candidate's 1988 election effort.

The final pages detail the finances of House candidates for calendar year 1987. Data include total receipts and disbursements, contributions from individuals and PAC's, cash-on-hand and debts owed by the committee. Again, transfers between committees of the same campaign have been subtracted.

*PAC contributions for 1984 and 1986 are as reported by PAC's. All other information is taken from the summary pages of the reports filed by the candidates' campaigns.
