FEC RELEASES 15-MONTH FIGURES ON 1988 CONGRESSIONAL CAMPAIGNS

WASHINGTON — Congressional candidates seeking election in 1987-88 raised \$179.93 million and spent \$112.75 million during the first 15 months of the election cycle. These figures come from campaign finance reports filed with the Federal Election Commission and cover the period January 1, 1987, or the inception of the campaign, through March 31, 1988. The figures represent an eight percent increase in money raised and spent when compared with the same period of the 1985-86 election cycle.

During the first quarter of 1988, Congressional candidates raised about \$61 million and spent nearly \$47 million. Senate candidates took in almost \$28 million, while House campaigns raised more than \$33 million. Spending in Senate races totalled almost \$22 million; House races came to about \$25 million.

Different pictures emerge when the 15-month figures for the Senate and House are analyzed separately. Senate spending totalled \$41.36 million, down 10 percent from '86. Fundraising by Senate candidates dropped one percent to \$78.67 million. Much of the decrease is attributable to a smaller number of candidates in open seat races (41 in '86, 26 in '88) and the fact that different states are involved in this election than two years ago.

Financial activity increased in House races when compared with '86: spending rose almost 23 percent to \$71.39 million, fundraising grew by nearly 16 percent to \$101.26 million. Some of the increase is due to the fact that there are 17 more incumbents seeking re-election this year than in '86.

Contributions from PAC's increased to both Senate and House candidates. Senate campaigns took in about \$19 million, up 16 percent from the same period two years ago. PAC's contributed just over \$34 million to House candidates, an increase of nearly 33 percent from '86.

A summary table breaks out the 1987-88 data for Senate and House candidates by party as well as candidate status (incumbent/challenger/open seat), and includes financial activity from special elections. A second summary table gives comparable figures for the '88 and '86 election cycles. Following the charts are lists showing the 50 top money raisers and spenders, for both the Senate and House, as well as those with the most cash-on-hand and outstanding debts. For the first time, House incumbents, challengers and open seat candidates are ranked separately.

On subsequent pages, individual Senate candidates are listed with total receipts and disbursements for each two-year cycle during which they reported financial activity. Transfers of funds between committees of the same campaign have been subtracted. Contributions from individuals and PAC's are listed for each cycle. PAC contributions for 1984 and 1986 are as reported by PAC's. All other information is taken from the summary pages of the reports filed by the candidates' campaigns. The cash-on-hand and debts owed by each campaign are provided for the end of each two-year cycle from December 31, 1982, through March 31, 1988. Some of the financial activity reported during the six-year period may relate to a prior election and should not automatically be presumed to be part of the candidate's 1988 election effort.

The final pages detail the finances of House candidates for the 15-month period. Data include total receipts and disbursements, contributions from individuals and PAC's, cash-on-hand and debts owed by the committee. Again, transfers between committees of the same campaign have been subtracted.
